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Soft Bamboo "double"



- a Bamboo yarn out of the ordinary

The yarn contains all of 70% of bamboo, which gives the yarn the softest experience and a special lightness. Comfortable to the skin, it makes it also very child-friendly. The texture is silky with a beautiful drape.

Bambus and environment - Bamboo is the fastest growing plant in the world and thus a great source of sustainable production.

Bamboo releases more oxygen than any other plant and grows without the use of pesticides. 23% cotton and 7% acrylic help to stabilize the soft bamboo and give the thread a good shape retention. Machine washable.

70% Bamboo/23% Cotton/7% Acrylic, 50 g/115 m.





YARN USAGE

Colour A: 100 g Colour B: 50 a Black: few meters

MATERIALS

Eyes: 8 mm Filling

Teething ring "Heart" Wooden ring: 55 mm Rattle cellophane Squekers 2 pcs.: 25 mm Rattle boxes 2 pcs.: 22 mm Crochet hook: 3,0 - 3,5 mm

Gauge: 28 sts/10 cm

The given amounts of yarn are for guidance only.

If nothing else is specified, work in spiral rounds. To finish the work, join the round with a sl st. Leave a 20 cm length of yarn and cut. Pull the yarn through the stitch...

Mounting of the safety eyes:

The eyes are inserted, and the rear stops to the eyes are pushed from the inside.

The rear stops can and should be a little hard to plug in to ensure that they are sticking well.

When making handcrafts and homemade things for babies, it is important to be careful with the assembly/mounting of the parts. It is particularly necessary to be careful with knots and loops.

Strap for pendant - size: L 8 cm x W 1 cm:

1.) 26 ch, turn.

2.) 25 dc, start in 2nd ch from hook, 1 t-ch

3.) 25 dc.

Break the yarn, add the Teething ring "Heart" or Wooden ring, and sew on the body.



Add filler to the snout.

Use the yarn end to sew the snout to the head. Embroider on the mouth and snout (see drawing).



EARS (COLOUR A, 2 X & B, 2 X)

1.) mr with 5 dc (5) Turn the centre ring.

From here, you crochet back and forth.

2.)	t-ch, *1 dc inc*	(10)
3.)	t-ch, *1 dc, 1 dc inc*	(15)
4.)	t-ch, *2 dc, 1 dc inc*	(20)

Hold the two parts against each other (one of each colour), back to back and with colour A crochet them together.

5.) t-ch, 20 dc (20)

Add 2 layers of Rattle cellophane to the ears. Cast off and use the yarn end to sew the ears to the head.

Hook Size & Tension

Crocheters crochet very differently: some crochet with a hook size 2,0 mm and obtain the same size of design and quality as a person who crochets with a hook size 4,0 mm. We owe this knowledge to the team of crocheters who join us. The key to crochet a specific size is a lot about the crochet style/hands/skills, rather than the size of hook. Therefore, we will recommend a range of hook sizes.



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
