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Tencel - your new favourite yarn.

Tencel is a organic sustainable natural material manufactured from wood chips, primarily from beech and eucalyptus. The wood is FSC certified and comes from natural culling of the woods or leftovers from other wood production. Tencel is the most sustainable of materials, made with the most utterly environmental concerns.

The uniqueness of Tencel - soft and mild for the skin. The composition of the fibres' smooth structure from beech and eucalyptus makes Tencel material very pleasant for the skin. It's softer than silk and smoother to the skin than wool and cotton and has also a fantastic absorbent quality.

YARN USAGE FOR THE SET 3 MONTHS (6 MONTHS):

3 months - for all 3 parts:

50 g Go handmades Couture garn **(single thread)** 150 g Go handmades Tencel garn **(double thread)**

6 months - for all 3 parts:

50 g Go handmades Couture garn (single thread) 150 g Go handmades Tencel garn (double thread

Double pointed needles (DPNs) or circular needles (Magic Loop) 3,5 and 4,5 mm.

Gauge with 3,5 mm needles (double thread): 26 sts stocking stitch = 10 cm

The indicated amount of yarn is for guidance only.

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HAT – WITH COUTURE EDGE 3 months (6 months)

Cast on 108 (120) sts with Tencel yarn (double thread) on 3,5 mm N and knit in the round.

Size 3 months:

{k4, p2}. **Size 6 months:** {k5, p2, k5, p2, k4, p2}.

Knit 3 rounds and make a cable on 4th round as follows:

Size 3 months:

{k4, p2, k4, p2, cable (over 4 sts), p2}, for a total of 6 times.

Size 6 months:

{k5, p2, k5, p2, cable (over 4 sts), p2}, for a total of 6 times.

Knit until the work measures 10 (11) cm, then start decreases on the round of the cable as follows:

UK Size 3 months:

{k2tog tbl, k2tog, p2, k2tog tbl, k2tog, p2, cable (over 4 knit sts), p2}. 1 row without decreases. {k2, p2tog, k2, p2tog, k4, p2tog}. 1 row without decreases. {k2tog, p1, k2tog, p1, cable (over 4 knit sts), p1}. {k1, p1, k1, p1, k2tog tbl, k2tog, p1}. Cut the yarn, pull thread through the remaining stitches, tighten and weave in the end.

Size 6 months:

{k2tog tbl, k1, k2tog, p2, k2tog tbl, k1, k2tog, p2, cable (over 4 knit sts), p2}. 1 row without decreases. {k3, p2tog, k3, p2tog, k4, p2tog}. 1 row without decreases. {s1 wyib, k2tog, psso, p1, s11 wyib, k2tog, psso, p1, k2tog tbl, p1}. Cut the yarn, pull thread through the remaining stitches, tighten and weave in the end.

On 4,5 mm N and with Couture yarn (single thread), pick up 54 (60) sts at the edge of the hat. Knit 1 row, purl 1 row, knit 1 row, purl 1 row, knit 1 row and bind off simultaneously. Weave in ends.



BOOTS – WITH COUTURE EDGE (2 X) 3 months (6 months)

Cast on 30 (34) sts with Couture yarn (single thread) on 4,5 mm N and knit 6 r.

Start knitting the boot in the round and change to Tencel yarn (double thread) on 3,5 mm N. Knit 1 round increasing by 6 sts evenly, for a total of 36 (40) sts.

Distribute the stitches in the next row as follows: k11 (13), p2, k4, p2, k4, p2, k11 (13). (- the cable is worked over the 2 x 4 knit sts in the center of the piece.) Knit until the piece measures 4 (5) cm.

Work 1 row with holes as follows: yo, k2tog, k1, repeat throughout the round (size 6 months ending with k2). Continue with cable pattern to approx. 1,5 cm – finish with 1 round (3 rounds) of the pattern. *Cut yarn.*

Keep the 14 central sts (cables upper part of the boot) on 1 N and slip the other sts on a piece of yarn or an aux N.

Knit 4 (5) cm flat (back and forth) over the 14 sts on the N with the cable pattern *Cut yarn.*

Start again in the center back of the boot with k11 (13), pick up 13 (15) sts (side), k14 (front), pick up 13 (15) sts (side), k11 (13). Total sts: 62 (70). Continue until there are 4 (5) garter stitch ridges, alternating purl and knit rounds. *Cut yarn*. To knit the sole, divide sts onto 4 needles as follows: 14 sts (front), 17 (21) sts (side), 14 sts (heel), 17 (21) sts (side).

Start from the right side and k13 over the front of the boot, knit the last st 2tog with the 1st side st, turn.

Slip 1 wyib, k12, knit last st 2tog with the 1st side st, turn.

Repeat the last row until all sts from the sides are knitted together with the sole.

Turn the work inside out and knit the sole's sts together with the heel's sts while binding off.

Weave in the ends and sew the Couture edge together at the top of the boot. Twist a string for a suitable length and pull it through the row with the holes.

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MITTENS – WITH COUTURE EDGE (2 X) 3 months (6 months)

Cast on 40 (44) sts on 3,5 mm N with Tencel (double thread). Purl 1 round and place stitch marker after 20 (22) sts.

Knit with cable pattern over the center 14 sts as follows:

k3 (4), p2, k4 (cable), p2, k4 (cable), p2, k23 (26). Knit up with cable every 4th round.

When the work measures 2,5 (3,5) cm, make 1 row with holes as follows: {yo, k2tog, k1 for a total of 6 (7) times, k2 (1)}. Repeat one more time.

Knit one round over all sts.

Increase 2 sts on each side as follows: {k1, kfb, k18 (20), kfb, k1} repeat one more time, up to a total of 44 (48) sts.

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Continue with the cable pattern until the mitten measures 8 (10) cm.

Decrease both sides of the mitten as follows: k2, k2tog, cable pattern until 4 sts before m, k2tog, k4, k2tog, knit until 4 sts before the end of the round, k2tog, k2.

Repeat this decrease every 2nd round for a total of 4 times.

Cut the yarn and pull thread through the remaining sts on the N, tighten and weave in the end.

With DPNs 4,5 mm and Couture yarn (single thread), pick up 30 (32) sts at the edge of the purl sts. Work two ridges (alternately purl 1 row, knit 1 row – for a total of 2 times), purl 2 r, knit 1 r, purl 1 row, knit 1 row binding off simultaneously.

Weave in the ends and twist a suitable length of Tencel yarn, pull it through the row with holes.



Good to know

Go handmade's collection is developed and handcrafted by the expert hands of passionate knitters. All are knitted to meet what we find is a medium tightness and what suits the article.

Needle size + tension

Knitters knit very differently: some knit with a needle size 2,0 mm and obtain the same size of design quality as a person who knits with a needle size 4,0 mm. We owe this knowledge to the team of knitters who join us. The key to knit a specific size is a lot about the knitting style/hands/skills, rather than the size of needles. Therefore, we will recommend a range of needle sizes.
