Color A.

The first round ends here. Place a marker.

BODY

Color A.

The body is crocheted as a continuation of the round where the legs are assembled.

 10.) 12 dc (12)
 11.) 2 dc inc, 11 dc (13)
 12.) 2 dc inc, 12 dc (14)
 13.) 2 dc inc, 13 dc (15)
 14. - 25.) 15 dc (15)

Place filling in the arm.

- 26.) *1 dc, dc 2 tog* to end (10)

Close and sew the top edge. The arms are mounted according to the illustration.

Use a long darning needle. On the outside of the arm, the needle is threaded through the button.

BUSTER

HEAD (COLOR A)

The head is crocheted as a continuation of the body.

- 1.) 1 dc, 7x 2 dc inc, 1 dc, 7x 2 dc inc (30)
 2.) *2 dc inc* to end (60)

Crochet dc unto the middle of the back, where the rounds will start from now on.

3. - 15.) 60 dc (60)
 16.) *8 dc, dc 2 tog* to end (54)
 17.) 54 dc (54)
 18.) *7 dc, dc 2 tog* to end (48)
 19.) *6 dc, dc 2 tog* to end (42)
 20.) 42 dc (42)
 21.) *5 dc, dc 2 tog* to end (36)
 22.) *4 dc, dc 2 tog* to end (30)

Put the eyes in the 13th round with 8 sts between them.

The stoppers for the eyes are placed on the inside, fasten them with the aid of a coin or something similar.

Place filling in the head's lower part.

- 23.) *3 dc, dc 2 tog* to end (24)
 24.) *2 dc, dc 2 tog* to end (18)

Place filling in the next part of the head.

- 25.) *1 dc, dc 2 tog* to end (12)
 26.) *dc 2 tog* to end (6)

Fill the rest of the head.

Finish with 1 sl st and fasten the thread ends.

Please look at the description for the eye indentation.

SNOUT (COLOR A)

- 1.) Work 7 ch. 2 dc into the 2nd ch from the hook, 4 dc, 3 dc in the last ch. Continue on the other side of the length of ch sts with: 5 dc (14)

Place a marker.

- 2.) 2 dc inc, 2 dc, 2x 2 dc inc,
2 dc, 2 dc inc, 6 dc (18)
- 3.) 2x 2 dc inc, 3 dc, 2x 2 dc inc,
3 dc, 2x 2 dc inc, 6 dc (24)
- 4.) 1 dc, 2x 2 dc inc, 5 dc, 2x 2 dc inc,
5 dc, 2x 2 dc inc, 7 dc (30)
- 5.) 1 dc, 2x 2 dc inc, 7 dc, 2x 2 dc inc,
7 dc, 2x 2 dc inc, 9 dc (36)
- 6.) 36 dc (36)
- 7.) 12 dc, 2 x dc 2 tog, 20 dc (34)
- 8.) 34 dc (34)

Complete with 1 sl st.

Place filling in the snout.

Use the yarn end to sew the snout onto the head.

(see ill.)

EAR (COLOR A, 2 X AND B, 2 X)

- 1.) cr with 5 dc (5)
- Turn the center ring. Crochet in rows from here on.
- 2.) t-ch, *2 dc inc* to end (10)
- 3.) *1 dc, 2 dc inc* to end (15)
- 4.) t-ch, *2 dc, 2 dc inc* to end (20)

Lay a color A and color B section purl on purl, and crochet them together:

- 5.) t-ch, 20 dc (20)

Sew the ears to the head.

TAIL POMPO

The pompom is made over a fork, or something similar. The yarn is wrapped around the fork about 35 times. A yarn end of about 30 cm is used to tie the loops together in the middle, and the loops are pushed off the fork. Cut the loops. The pompom will need trimming so it is round. The long yarn end in the middle is used to sew the pompom to Buster's backside.

BLOUSE (COLOR A AND B)

Each round is completed with a sl st and started with a ch, so the change of color will look good.

At the change of color, the sl st is always in the new color.

Begin with color B.

- 1.) 60 ch is closed to a ring with 1 sl st (60)
- 2.) 60 dc (60)
- 3.) 60 dc (60)

Change to color A.

- 4.) *8 dc, dc 2 tog* to end (54)
- 5.) 54 dc (54)

Change to color B.

- 6.) *11 dc, dc 2 tog, 12 dc, dc 2 tog*
to end (50)
- 7.) 50 dc (50)

Change to color A.

- 8.) *10 dc, dc 2 tog, 11 dc, dc 2 tog* to end
(46)
- 9.) 46 dc (46)

Change to color B.

- 10.) *9 dc, dc 2 tog, 10 dc, dc 2 tog* to end
(42)
- 11.) 42 dc (42)

Change to color A.

- 12.) *8 dc, dc 2 tog, 9 dc, dc 2 tog*
to end (38)
- 13.) 38 dc (38)

Close off and fasten the ends.

The back piece and the front piece are crocheted onto the already finished parts, each over 19 st.

Back piece:

The back piece starting chain stitch is crocheted in the 29th st of the previous round.

Crochet in rows from here on.

Begin with color B.

- 14.) 1 ch, dc 2 tog, 15 dc, dc 2 tog (17)
 15.) t-ch, 17 dc (17)
Change to color A.
 16.) t-ch, dc 2 tog, 13 dc, dc 2 tog (15)
 17.) t-ch, 15 dc (15)
Change to color B.
 18.) t-ch, dc 2 tog, 11 dc, dc 2 tog (13)
 19.) t-ch, 13 dc (13)
Change to color A.
 20.) dc 2 tog, 9 dc, dc 2 tog (11)
 21.) 11 dc (11)
Change to color B.
 22. - 23.) 11 dc (11)
Change to color A.
 24. - 25.) 11 dc (11)
Change to color B.
 26. - 27.) 11 dc (11)
 Close.

Front piece:

The front piece is crocheted on the remaining 19 st in the same way as the back piece. Do not close.

Crochet 1 ch after the front piece's last st. Turn the piece, and crochet 10 sl st. Crochet 1 sl st, 1 ch, and 1 sl st in the same (corner) stitch.

Now crochet 12 sl st down the side of the front piece, and 12 sl st up the side of the back piece. Crochet 1 sl st, 1 ch, and 1 sl st in the corner stitch, crochet 1 sl st in each st on the back piece's upper edge, and again 1 sl st, 1 ch, and 1 sl st in the next corner stitch.

Now crochet 12 sl st down the side of the front piece, and 12 sl st up the side of the back piece. *Close off and fasten the ends.*

Braces (color B, 2 x)

For each suspender, crochet 12 ch on each corner of the back piece.

Crochet dc beginning at the 5th ch (creating an eyelet) and to the back piece's corner.

Close off and fasten the ends.

Sew the two small buttons on the front piece's corners, and fasten the suspenders' eyelets.

CAP (COLOR B)

- 1.) cr with 6 dc (6)
 2.) *2 dc inc* to end (12)
 3.) *1 dc, 2 dc inc* to end (18)
 4.) *2 dc, 2 dc inc* to end (24)
 5.) *3 dc, 2 dc inc* to end (30)
 6.) *4 dc, 2 dc inc* to end (36)
 7.) *5 dc, 2 dc inc* to end (42)
 8.) *6 dc, 2 dc inc* to end (48)
 9.) 48 dc in the back loop only (48)
 10.) *6 dc, dc 2 tog* to end, in the back loop only (42)
 11.) *12 dc, dc 2 tog* to end (39)
Crochet in rows from here on.
 12.) t-ch, 12 dc in the back loop only (12)
 13.) t-ch, dc 2 tog, 8 dc, dc 2 tog (10)
 14.) Miss 1 st, 1 sl st, 6 dc, dc 2 tog (8)
 15.) Miss 1 st, 1 sl st, 1 dc, 2 htr, 1 dc, dc 2 tog. (6)

Close off and fasten the ends.

HEAD (COLOR A)

The head is crocheted as a continuation of the body.

1.) 1 dc, 7x 2 dc inc, 1 dc, 7x 2 dc inc (30)

2.) *2 dc inc* to end (60)

Crochet dc unto the middle of the back, where the rounds will start from now on.

3. - 15.) 60 dc (60)

16.) *8 dc, dc 2 tog* to end (54)

17.) 54 dc (54)

18.) *7 dc, dc 2 tog* to end (48)

19.) *6 dc, dc 2 tog* to end (42)

20.) 42 dc (42)

21.) *5 dc, dc 2 tog* to end (36)

22.) *4 dc, dc 2 tog* to end (30)

Place filling in the head's lower part.

23.) *3 dc, dc 2 tog* to end (24)

24.) *2 dc, dc 2 tog* to end (18)

Put the eyes in the 13th round with 10 sts between them. The stoppers for the eyes are placed on the inside, fasten them with the aid of a coin or something similar. Fill the rest of the head.

25.) *1 dc, dc 2 tog* to end (12)

26.) *dc 2 tog* to end (6)

Close off and fasten the ends.

TRUNK (COLOR A)

1.) cr with 8 dc (8)

2.) 8 dc in the back loop only (8)

3. - 5.) 8 dc (8)

6.) 3 dc, 2x 2 dc inc, 3 dc (10)

7. - 12.) 10 dc (10)

13.) 4 dc, 2x 2 dc inc, 4 dc (12)

14. - 21. 12 dc (12)

- 22.) 3 dc, 2 dc inc, 4 dc, 2 dc inc, 3 dc (14)
 23.) 3 sl st, 3 dc, 2x 2 dc inc,
 3 dc, 3 sl st (16)
 24.) 4 sl st, 2 dc, 2 dc inc,
 2 dc, 2 dc inc, 2 dc, 4 sl st (18)
 25.) 5 sl st, 2 dc, 2 dc inc, 2 dc,
 2 dc inc, 2 dc, 5 sl st (20)
 26.) 4 sl st, 2 dc inc, 3 dc, 2 dc inc,
 2 dc, 2 dc inc, 3 dc, 2 dc inc, 4 sl st (24)

Close off. Put some filling in, and sew the trunk to the head in the following way:

The 8 sl st are turned down and fastened with pins just above the head's 4th round. The trunk's first middle is fastened just above the head's 11th round. When the trunk is placed symmetrically, sew it on.

LOWER JAW (COLOR A)

- 1.) cr with 4 dc (4)
 Turn the stitch ring.
 2.) t-ch, 2 dc inc, 2 dc, 2 dc inc (6)
 The lower jaw is sewn on below the trunk.

EAR (COLOR A, 2 X)

- 1.) cr with 4 dc, Do not close cr (4)
 Turn the center ring.
 Crochet in rows from here on.
 2.) t-ch, *2 dc inc* to end (8)
 3.) t-ch, *1 dc, 2 dc inc* to end (12)
 4.) t-ch, *2 dc, 2 dc inc* to end (16)
 5.) t-ch, *3 dc, 2 dc inc* to end (20)
 6.) t-ch, *4 dc, 2 dc inc* to end (24)
 7.) t-ch, *5 dc, 2 dc inc* to end (28)
 8.) t-ch, *6 dc, 2 dc inc* to end (32)

Close off.

One side of the half circle is folded almost to the middle, and sewn to the ear's bottom edge. The ear is sewn onto the head.

TAIL (COLOR A)

Cut some yarn ends of about 10 cm, and draw them through a stitch in the 6th round so that they are double. Make a braid, tie a yarn end to the open end to secure it, and trim the tail pom-pom.

SCARF (COLOR B AND C)

Crochet in rows.

Begin with color C.

- 1.) 7 ch, 1 dc into the 2nd
 m from the hook, 5 dc (6)
 2.) t-ch, 6 dc (6)
 Change to color B.
 3.) t-ch, 6 dc (6)
 4.) t-ch, 6 dc (6)
 Change to color C.

Continue to change color every other row, until you have 39 stripes (20 color C, and 19 color B).

Tie the fringe with 1 color C and 1 color B thread, respectively, in each of the 6 stitches at the ends.

HAT (COLOR B AND C)

Each round is completed with a sl st and started with a ch, so the change of color will look good.

At the change of color, the sl st is always in the new color. Begin with color C yarn.

- 1.) cr with 4 dc.
 The thread end at the start should be a little longer, as it's going to be used to fasten the pom-pom. (4)
 2.) *1 dc, 2 dc inc* to end (6)
 Change to color B.
 3.) *2 dc, 2 dc inc* to end (8)
 4.) 8 dc (8)
 Change to color C.

5.)	*3 dc, 2 dc inc* to end	(10)
6.)	10 dc	(10)
<i>Change to color B.</i>		
7.)	*4 dc, 2 dc inc* to end	(12)

POMPOM FOR THE HAT (COLOR B AND C)

The pompom is made over a fork, or something similar. Color B and C yarn is wrapped about 30 times around the fork. A yarn end of about 30 cm is used to tie the loops together in the middle, and the loops are pushed off the fork. Cut the loops. The pompom will need trimming so it is round. The long yarn end in the middle, and the yarn end from the hat's top is used to fasten the pompom.



KARLA

HEAD (COLOR A)

The head is crocheted as a continuation of the body.

1.) 1 dc, 7x 2 dc inc, 1 dc, 7x 2 dc inc (30)

2.) *2 dc inc* to end (60)

Crochet dc onto the middle of the back, where the rounds will start from now on.

3. - 15.) 60 dc (60)

16.) *8 dc, dc 2 tog* to end (54)

17.) 54 dc (54)

18.) *7 dc, dc 2 tog* to end (48)

19.) *6 dc, dc 2 tog* to end (42)

20.) 42 dc (42)

21.) *5 dc, dc 2 tog* to end (36)

22.) *4 dc, dc 2 tog* to end (30)

Place filling in the head's lower part.

23.) *3 dc, dc 2 tog* to end (24)

24.) *2 dc, dc 2 tog* to end (18)

Put the eyes in the 14th round with 6 sts between them. The stoppers for the eyes are placed on the inside, fasten them with the aid of a coin or something similar. Fill the rest of the head.

25.) *1 dc, dc 2 tog* to end (12)

26.) *dc 2 tog* to end (6)

Close off and fasten the thread ends.

Please look at the description for the eye indentation.

SNOUT (COLOR A)

1.) Work 11 ch. 2 dc into the 2nd ch from the hook, 8 dc, 3 dc in the last ch. Continue on the other side of the length of ch sts with: 9 dc (22)

2.) 2 dc inc, 10 dc, 2 dc inc, 10 dc (24)

3.) *2x 2 dc inc, 2 dc, 2 dc inc, 4 dc, 2 dc inc, 2 dc* to end 2x (32)

- 4.) *2 dc inc, 1 dc, 2 dc inc, 1 dc,
2 dc inc, 5 dc, 2 dc inc, 5 dc*
to end 2x (40)
5. - 8.) 40 dc (40)
- 9.) 3 dc, dc 2 tog, 8 dc, dc 2 tog,
8 dc, dc 2 tog, 8 dc, dc 2 tog, 5 dc (36)
10. - 11.) 36 dc (36)
- Close with a sl st, sew the snout onto the head,
but leave a small opening. Fill the snout, and close
the small opening.*

NOSTRILS (COLOR A, 2 X)

Crochet a cr with 6 dc, close it with 1 sl st.
Sew the nostrils onto the snout.

EAR (COLOR A, 2 X AND B, 2 X)

Work 5 ch. 1 tr into the 3rd st
from the hook, 1 htr.
1 dc and 1 picot (2 ch, 1 dc
into the 2nd st from the hook).
Continue on the other side of
the length of ch sts with:
1 dc, 1 htr, 1 tr.

*Close on part. Put the two parts purl to purl, and
crochet them together.
Sew the ears to the head.*

TAIL (COLOR A)

*Cut some yarn ends of about 10 cm, and draw
them through a stitch in the 6th round so that they
are double. Make a braid, tie a yarn end to the
open end to secure it, and trim the tail pompom.*

SHORTS (COLOR B)

- 1.) 60 ch is closed to a ring with 1 sl st (60)
From now on every round is closed with 1 sl st.
- 2.) 60 dc (60)
- 3.) 1 ch, *1 dc, 1 ch, miss 1 st*
to end 30 x (60)
4. - 5.) 1 ch, 60 dc (60)
6. - 7.) 2 ch, 60 htr (60)
- 8.) 4 ch, miss 2 sts,
58 htr (60, incl. 2 ch)
9. - 12.) 2 ch, 2 htr in the two
ch from previous round, 58 htr (60)
- 13.) 6 ch. Put the crochet needle in
the middle on the front and
crochet 30 htr, plus 6 htr in the
6 ch. *A trouser leg is formed.* (36)
- 14.) Crochet the other trouser leg in the
same way with 30 htr plus 6 htr. (36)

Close off and fasten the ends.

Drawstring (color B)

*Crochet 100 ch, close, and fasten the thread ends.
Pull the ch-thread through the holes in the 2nd
round.*

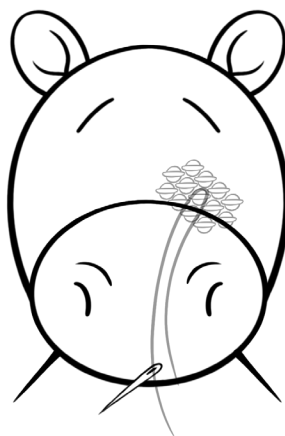
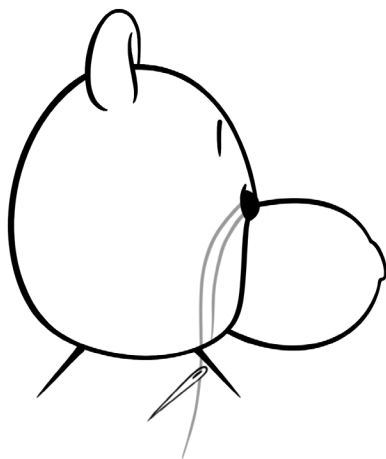
SCARF (COLOR B)

Crochet in rows.

- 1.) Work 82 ch. 1 htr into the 3rd
st from the hook, 79 htr (80)
- 2.) 2 +ch, 80 htr (80)
- Close off and fasten the ends.*

EYE INDENTATION MADE ON A FINISHED CROCHETED ANIMAL

- With the same yarn as the head was crocheted/ knit with, thread about 25 cm.
- The needle is led in under the chin and out on one side of the eye.
- Sew through a few stitches by the eye. The needle is then led out again down by the chin. Tighten the thread, so that the pressure creates an indentation by the eye.
- To maintain the pressure on the indentation, sew through a few stitches by the chin.
- Repeat the process on the other side of the same eye.
- The indentation is now complete. If the indentation needs to be deeper, the process can be repeated, and tightened by the eye's edge at the top.
- Remember to tighten when the needle is taken out by the chin, and throughout the sewing through the stitches, so that the indentation is maintained.
- Repeat the process on the opposite eye.

Hook Size + Tension

Crocheters crochet very differently: some crochet with a hook size 2,0 mm and obtain the same size of design and quality as a person who crochets with a hook size 4,0 mm. We owe this knowledge to the team of crocheters who join us.

The key to crochet a specific size is a lot about the crochet style/hands/skills, rather than the size of hook. Therefore, we will recommend a range of hook sizes.
