
#### **SNOUT**

Sew the snout right under the eyes.	

#### Shape the head and the eye hollows:

Thread the yarn for about 25 cm. Insert the needle under the chin and up by the inner side of the eye. Stitch over one stitch and bring the needle out at the lower part of the chin. Tighten the thread so that the pressure creates a depression above the eye. To maintain the pressure on the depression, stitch through a couple of stitches at the lower part of the chin. The depression on one eye is now completed. Repeat the process on the opposite eye.



#### NOSTRILS (2 X)

1.) mr with 6 dc (6) Finish off with 1 sl st.

Sew the nostrils on the snout.

#### EARS 4 X

1.) 5 ch, 1 tr in the third ch from the hook, 1 htr, in last st 1 dc, 1 picot.

On opposite side crochet 1 dc, 1 htr, 1 tr Finish off the first 2 ears.

Place the 2 ears together wrong sided and crochet them together as follows:

2.) 1 ch, 9 dc (9) Sew the ears to the head.

Insert squeakers and filling into the arms. Sew the arms to the head.

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#### **COMFORT BLANKET**

Crochet Comfort Blanket like a Granny Square as follows:

Each round starts with 3 ch replacing the 1st tr. Finish with 1 sl st in the 3rd ch at the start of the rd.

- 1.) mr, \*3 tr, 2 ch\* in ring x 4
- 2.) \*3 tr, 2 ch, 3 tr, 2 ch around the 2 ch from the previous rd\* in every corner x 4
- 3.) 3 sl st from the corner\*, 3 tr, 2 ch, 3 tr, 2 ch around the 2 ch from the previous rd of the corner groups, 3 tr, 2 ch around the 2 ch from the previous rd of the corner groups\* x 4
- 4. 15.) Crochet as rd 3, which increases by 1 tr gr + 2 ch around the 2 ch from the previous r.

#### STRAP FOR TPE FIGURE (STAR)

- 1.) 12 sl st. 1 t-ch.
- 2. 3.) 12 dc fra the 2nd stitch, 1 t-ch.
- 4.) 12 dc.

Add the TPE star and sew around one of the corners 2 sl st.

#### STRAP FOR WOODEN RING

- 1.) 12 sl st. 1 t-ch.
- 2. 3.) 12 dc fra the 2nd stitch, 1 t-ch.
- 4.) 12 dc.

Add the wooden ring and sew around one of the corners 2 sl st.

# STRAP FOR RATTLE RING

- 1.) 15 sl st. 1 t-ch.
- 2. 3.) 15 dc fra the 2nd stitch, 1 t-ch.
- 4.) 15 dc.

Add the rattle ring and sew around one of the corners 2 sl st.

# STRAP FOR TPE FIGURE (PAW)

- 1.) 8 sl st. 1 t-ch.
- 2. 3.) 8 dc fra the 2nd stitch, 1 t-ch.
- 4.) 8 dc.

Add the TPE paw and sew around one of the corners 2 sl st.

#### STRAP FOR RING LINK

- 1.) 8 sl st. 1 t-ch.
- 2. 3.) 8 dc fra the 2nd stitch, 1 t-ch.
- 4.) 8 dc.

Sew the strap on top of the head.

The Sensory Hippo can be hung by the strap. (8)

# Hook Size & Tension

Crocheters crochet very differently: some crochet with a hook size 2,0 mm and obtain the same size of design and quality as a person who crochets with a hook size 4,0 mm. We owe this knowledge to the team of crocheters who join us. The key to crochet a specific size is a lot about the crochet style/hands/skills, rather than the size of hook. Therefore, we will recommend a range of hook sizes.



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
