
Pattern Elephant pram chain



Crocheted in Soft Bamboo "fine" 70% Bamboo/23% Cotton/7% Acrylic, 50 g/180 m.



YARN USAGE Elephant pram chain L 40 cm 100 g

MATERIALS Eyes: 2 pairs 5 mm Wooden beads: 6 pcs 20 mm Elastic string 1 meter Ring link: 2 pcs D60 mm Filling

Crochet hook: 2,5 - 3,0 mm Gauge: 28 dc/10 cm Skill level: ★★ of 5.

Elephant pram chain L 40 cm

MATERIALS

Eyes: 2 pairs 5 mm Wooden beads: 6 pcs 20 mm Elastic string 1 meter Ring link: 2 pcs D60 cm Filling Crochet hook: 2,5 - 3,0 mm

Gauge: 24 m/10 cm

The given amounts of yarn are for guidance only.

REQUIRED MOUNTING STEPS

Eyes in yarn projects (0-3 years)

For projects for children 0-3 years: Mounting of eyes requires melting of end pieces and special stitching.

The yarn contains all of 70% of bamboo, which gives the yarn the softest experience and a special lightness. Comfortable to the skin, it makes it also very childfriendly. The texture is silky with a beautiful drape.

Bambus and environment - Bamboo is the fastest growing plant in the world and thus a great source of sustainable production.

Bamboo releases more oxygen than any other plant and grows without the use of pesticides.

23% cotton and 7% acrylic help to stabilize the soft bamboo and give the thread a good

shape retention. Machine washable. 70% Bamboo/23% Cotton/7% Acrylic,

50 g/180 m.

EARS (4 X)


Close off and use the rest of the yarn to sew the ears of the head with.

TAIL

Make a loop from a 40 cm piece of yarn. Pass the needle under a stitch on the back of the elephant, insert the needle into the loop and pull it through. Pull the yarn through the loop and then crochet 10 sl st. Break the yarn and pull the last stitch to form a knot.

Shape the head and eye socket:

Thread approximately 25 cm of yarn. The needle is inserted under the chin and up at the inside of the eye. A stitch is sewn over and the needle is brought out below the chin. Tighten the thread so that the pressure forms a depression above the eye. To keep the pressure on the indentation, sew through a few stitches below the chin. The socket on one eye is now finished.

Hook Size + Tension

Crocheters crochet very differently: some crochet with a hook size 2,0 mm and obtain the same size of design and quality as a person who crochets with a hook size 4,0 mm. We owe this knowledge to the team of crocheters who join us. The key to crochet a specific size is a lot about the crochet style/hands/skills, rather than the size of hook. Therefore, we will recommend a range of hook sizes.
