YARN USAGE

Sensory Teddy on TPE ring H 14 cm: 50 g For the nose and eyes 1 meter black

MATERIALS

Eyes 10 mm TPE ring: D75 Rattle cellophane: 10 x 10 cm Rattle box: D22 x 19 mm Squeaker: 2 pcs 25 x 14 mm Filling Crochet hook: 2,5 - 3,0 mm

Gauge: 30 fm/10 cm

The given amounts of yarn are for guidance only.

REQUIRED MOUNTING STEPS

Eyes in yarn projects (0-3 years)

For projects for children 0-3 years: Mounting of eyes requires melting of end pieces and special stitching.



Shape the head/eye sockets:

Insert the needle beneath the head and up the inner side of the eye. Sew over a stitch at the eye stem, and lead the needle out beneath the head. Then, insert the needle through the next stitch and up the inner side of the other eye. Again, sew over a stitch at the eye stem, and once again, lead the the needle out beneath the head. Tighten the thread, allowing the tension to create indentations. Hold the tension and tie two knots to preserve the indentations. The eye sockets are done. The shaping of the head/eye sockets can also be done before the eyes are mounted.

HAIR

Cut 15 pieces of yarn, each 15cm long. Each strand should be pulled halfway under/ through a stitch, most easily done with a crochet hook.

Each strand is mounted under 1 stitch, in three rows, and 5 times per row.

Each strand is secured by tying two knots at the stitch.

Once all strands are mounted, cut the yarn to the desired length.

Hook Size & Tension

Crocheters crochet very differently: some crochet with a hook size 2,0 mm and obtain the same size of design and quality as a person who crochets with a hook size 4,0 mm. We owe this knowledge to the team of crocheters who join us. The key to crochet a specific size is a lot about the crochet style/hands/skills, rather than the size of hook. Therefore, we will recommend a range of hook sizes.
