#### YARN USAGE:

50 g Go handmade Vintage 100 g Go handmade Teddy

50 cm of black yarn for the nose and mouth

#### **MATERIAL:**

Eyes 10 mm

Filling

Crochet hook (Teddy): 4.0 - 4.5 mm Crochet hook (Vintage): 2.5 - 3.5 mm

The given amounts of yarn are for guidance only.

#### Teddy basserne is available as a kit:

Please note that the contents of the kit may vary from the stated material usage in the universal pattern.

#### **REQUIRED MOUNTING STEPS**

Eyes in yarn projects (0-3 years)

For projects for children 0-3 years: Mounting of eyes requires melting of end pieces and special stitching.

## ASSEMBLY AND SHAPING OF TEDDY BASSERNE

If nothing else is specified, work in spiral rounds. To finish the work, join the round with a sl st. Leave a 20 cm length of yarn and cut. Pull the yarn through the stitch.

Cut the yarn and pull through the stitches, tighten and sew the head together.

#### Shape the head/eye sockets:

Insert the needle beneath the head and up the inner side of the eye. Sew over a stitch at the eye stem, and lead the needle out beneath the head.

Then, insert the needle through the next stitch and up the inner side of the other eye. Again, sew over a stitch at the eye stem, and once again, lead the the needle out beneath the head. Tighten the thread, allowing the tension to create indentations.

Hold the tension and tie two knots to preserve the indentations. The eye sockets are done. The shaping of the head/eye sockets can also be done before

the eyes are mounted. Embroider nose/mouth as an upside down "Y".

Sew the head onto the body.





#### STRENGTHEN AND SHAPE THE **AREA AROUND THE EYES**




Work with Vintage Yarn.

1.)	mr with 6 dc	(6)
2.)	*1 dc, 2 dc inc*	(9)
3.)	*2 dc, 2 dc inc*	(12)
4.)	*3 dc, 2 dc inc*	(15)
5.)	*4 dc, 2 dc inc*	(18)
6.)	*5 dc, 2 dc inc*	(21)
7 13.)	21 dc	(21)

Fold the ear slightly at the opening and sew it onto the side of the head, at eye level.

Sew the head onto the body.



#### ARM (2 X)

Start with Vintage Yarn.

Crochet 9 ch st, then start at the 1.) 2. chain from the hook. 2 dc inc in 1. ch, 6 dc, 3 dc in the next ch. Now crochet 7 dc on the opposite side. (18)2. - 9.) 18 dc

(18)2 dc, dc 2 tog, 7 dc, dc 2 tog, 5 dc 10.) (16)Switch to the Teddy yarn.

11. - 26.) 16 dc (16)27.) \*dc 2 tog\*

28.) \*dc 2 tog\* (4)Filling is placed in the arms.



#### **LEG (2 X)**

Start with the Vintage yarn.

Crochet 11 ch st, then start at the 1.) 2. chain from the hook. 2 dc inc in 1. ch, 8 dc, 3 dc in the next ch. Now crochet 9 dc on the opposite side (22)2. - 9.) 22 dc (22)1 dc, dc 2 tog, 9 dc, dc 2 tog, 8 dc (20) 10.) Switch to the Teddy yarn. 11. - 24.) 20 dc (20)25.) \*dc 2 tog\* (10)\*dc 2 tog\* 26.) (5)

Filling is placed in the legs. Sew the legs onto the body. Sew through the hooves 2 - 3 times using approximately 25 cm of Vintage yarn. Tighten to shape the hooves and fasten the yarn.

## Good to know

### Hook Size & Tension

Crocheters crochet very differently: some crochet with a hook size 2,0 mm and obtain the same size of design and quality as a person who crochets with a hook size 4,0 mm. We owe this knowledge to the team of crocheters who join us. The key to crochet a specific size is a lot about the crochet style/hands/skills, rather than the size of hook. Therefore, we will recommend a range of hook sizes.



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
