Alpaca family



Crocheted in Go handmade's Curly: 59 % Polyester / 12 % Nylon / 29 % Acrylic 50 g / 120 m and in Go handmade's 'Soft Bamboo "Double": 70% Bamboo/23% Cotton/7% Acrylic 50g/ 115 m.



If you desire a smaller size of Alpaca, it can be crocheted with a single thread.

YARN USAGE

Alpaca H 35 cm

Curly (double thread): 200 g

Soft Bamboo „double“: 50 g

Alpaca H 25 cm

Curly (double thread): 150 g

Soft Bamboo „double“: 50 g

MATERIALS

Filling

Eyes: 14 mm en 12 mm

Nose: 16 mm en 12 mm

Crochet hook (Curly): 5,0 - 6,0 mm

Crochet hook (Soft): 4,0 - 5,0 mm

YARN USAGE

LARGE ALPACA H 35 CM:

Curly (*double thread*): 200 g
Soft Bamboo „double“: 50 g

SMALL ALPACA H 25 CM:

Curly (*double thread*): 150 g
Soft Bamboo „double“: 50 g

MATERIALS

Filling

Eyes: 14 & 12 mm

Nose: 16 & 12 mm

Crochet hook (Curly): 5,0 - 6,0 mm

Crochet hook (Soft Bamboo „double“):
4,0 - 5,0 mm

The given amounts of yarn are for guidance only.

REQUIRED MOUNTING STEPS

Eyes in yarn projects (0-3 years)

For projects for children 0-3 years:
Mounting of eyes requires melting of
end pieces and special stitching.

ABBREVIATIONS AND DEFINITIONS

st	Stitch
cr	Magic ring
ch	Chain stitch
sl st	Slip stitch
dc	Double crochet
htr	Half treble
dc inc	Increase (2 dc in one st)
dc dec	Decrease (2 dc crocheted together)
...	The instructions shown in these brackets must be repeated for the whole round/ row or with the number after x.
(..)	At the end of the line - indicates the total number of stitches.

If nothing else is specified, work in spiral rounds. To finish the work, join the round with a sl st. Leave a 20 cm length of yarn and cut. Pull the yarn through the stitch.

It is recommended that the filling continues on an ongoing basis as the work progresses.

LARGE ALPACA

Legs: crochet with Soft Bamboo „double“ and Curly (double thread).

Body & Neck, Head, Ears and Nose: crochet with Curly (double thread).

LEGS (4 X)

Begin with Soft Bamboo „double“.

- 1.) cr with 5 dc (5)
- 2.) 2 dc in each st (10)
- 3.) *1 dc, 1 dc inc* (15)
- 4.) *4 dc, 1 dc inc* (18)

Change to Curly.

5. - 10.) 18 dc (18)

BODY AND NECK

Start with the stomach between the four legs:

- 1.) cr with 8 dc (8)
- 2.) Crochet 8 dc, each leg is then crocheted to the cr with 2 of the stitches. Do **not** cut the yarn. (8)

The outer sides of the body and the neck:

- 1.) *skip the first 2 st on the next leg, crochet 12 dc* x 4 (48)
2. - 3.) 48 dc (48)
- 4.) *7 dc, 1 dc inc* (54)
- 5.) 54 dc (54)
- 6.) *8 dc, 1 dc inc* (60)
7. - 11.) 60 dc (60)
- 12.) *4 dc, 1 dc dec* x 3, 24 dc, *1 dc dec, 4 dc* x 3 (54)
- 13.) 54 dc (54)
- 14.) 3 dc, 1 dc dec, *6 dc, 1 dc dec* x 2, 12 dc, *1 dc dec, 6 dc* x 2, 1 dc dec, 3 dc (48)

- 15.) 48 dc (48)
- 16.) 2 dc, 1 dc dec, *3 dc, 1 dc dec* x 3, 10 dc, *1 dc dec, 3 dc* x 3, 1 dc dec, 2 dc (40)
- 17.) 40 dc (40)
- 18.) 1 dc, 1 dc dec, *2 dc, 1 dc dec* x 2, 3 dc, 1 dc dec, 8 dc, 1 dc dec, 3 dc, *1 dc dec, 2 dc* x 2, 1 dc dec, 1 dc (32)
- 19.) 32 dc (32)
- 20.) 2 dc, 1 dc dec, *1 dc, 1 dc dec* x 3, 6 dc, *1 dc dec, 1 dc* x 3, 1 dc dec, 2 dc (24)
- 21.) *4 dc, 2 dc dec* x 4 (20)
22. - 35.) 20 dc (20)

Stuff the body, neck and legs with fibrefill.

For the tail, cut lengths of yarn of approx. 14 cm.

Pull them through a stitch so that the yarn is double.

The knots and cut the tail to make it look good.

HEAD

Crocheting of the head continues from the neck.

- 1.) *1 dc, 1 dc inc* x 4, 4 dc, *1 dc inc, 1 dc* x 4 (28)
- 2.) *2 dc, 1 dc inc* x 4, 4 dc, *1 dc inc, 2 dc* x 4 (36)
- 3.) *4 dc, 1 dc inc* x 4, 4 dc, *1 dc inc, 2 dc* x 4 (44)
4. - 8.) 44 dc (44)
- 9.) 8 dc, 1 dc dec, 2 dc, 1 dc dec, 16 dc, 1 dc dec, 2 dc, 1 dc dec, 8 dc (40)
- 10.) 40 dc (40)
- 11.) 7 dc, 1 dc dec, 2 dc, 1 dc dec, 14 dc, 1 dc dec, 2 dc, 1 dc dec, 7 dc (36)
- 12.) 36 dc (36)

- 13.) 6 dc, 1 dc dec, 2 dc,
1 dc dec, 12 dc, 1 dc dec,
2 dc, 1 dc dec, 6 dc (32)

Attach the eyes after the 11th round with 8 cm distance between the eyes.

- 14.) 5 dc, 1 dc dec, 2 dc,
1 dc dec, 10 dc, 1 dc dec,
2 dc, 1 dc dec, 5 dc (28)

- 15.) 4 dc, 1 dc dec, 2 dc,
1 dc dec, 8 dc, 1 dc dec,
2 dc, 1 dc dec, 4 dc (24)

- 16.) 3 dc, 1 dc dec, 2 dc,
1 dc dec, 6 dc, 1 dc dec,
2 dc, 1 dc dec, 3 dc (20)

- 17.) 2 dc, 1 dc dec, 2 dc,
1 dc dec, 4 dc, 1 dc dec,
2 dc, 1 dc dec, 2 dc (16)

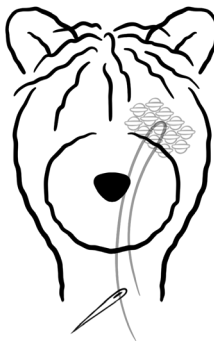
- 18.) 2 dc, 1 dc dec, 1 dc dec, 4 dc,
1 dc dec, 1 dc dec, 2 dc (12)

Stuff the head and sew the opening together.

Shape the head and the eye sockets:

Thread the yarn a with approx. 25 cm yarn.
Insert the needle under the chin and up by the inner side of the eye. Stitch over one stitch and bring the needle out at the lower part of the chin. Tighten the thread so that the pressure creates a depression above the eye. To maintain the pressure on the depression, stitch through a couple of stitches at the lower part of the chin. The depression on one eye is now completed. Repeat the process on the opposite eye.

EARS (2 X)

- | | | |
|----------|------------------|------|
| 1.) | cr with 4 dc | (4) |
| 2.) | 2 dc in each st | (8) |
| 3.) | *1 dc, 1 dc inc* | (12) |
| 4. - 6.) | 12 dc | (12) |
| 7.) | *4 dc, 1 dc dec* | (10) |
| 8.) | 10 dc | (10) |

Use the yarn ends to sew the ears onto the head.

For the hair, cut lengths of yarn of approx. 14 cm.

Pull them through a stitch so that the yarn is double.

Tie knots and cut hair to make it look good.

NOSE

| 1.) | cr with 6 dc | (6) |
| 2.) | 2 dc in each st | (12) |
| 3.) | *1 dc, 1 dc inc* | (18) |
| 4.) | *2 dc, 1 dc inc* | (24) |
| 5.) | 24 dc | (24) |
| 6.) | *2 dc, 1 dc dec* | (18) |

The nose is added in the middle of the centre ring.

As an alternative the nose may be embroidered on.

Use the yarn ends to sew the nose onto the head.

SMALL ALPACA

Body & Neck, Head, Ears and Nose:
crochet with Curly (double thread).

Legs: crochet with Soft Bamboo „double“ and Curly (double thread).

Stuff the body and neck with fibrefill.

Make the tail in the same way as Large Alpaca's tail.

HEAD

Crocheting of the head continues from the neck.

- 1.) 2 dc, *1 dc inc* x 10, 3 dc (25)
- 2.) 2 dc, *1 dc inc, 1 dc* x 10,
1 dc inc, 2 dc (36)
3. - 7.) 36 dc (36)
- 8.) 6 dc, 1 dc dec, 2 dc, 1 dc dec,
12 dc, 1 dc dec, 2 dc, 1 dc dec, 6 dc (32)
- 9.) 5 dc, 1 dc dec, 2 dc, 1 dc dec,
10 dc, 1 dc dec, 2 dc, 1 dc dec, 5 dc (28)
- 10.) 4 dc, 1 dc dec, 2 dc, 1 dc dec,
8 dc, 1 dc dec, 2 dc, 1 dc dec, 4 dc (24)
- 11.) 3 dc, 1 dc dec, 2 dc, 1 dc dec,
6 dc, 1 dc dec, 2 dc, 1 dc dec, 3 dc (20)

Attach the eyes after the 9th round with 8 cm distance between the eyes.

- 12.) 2 dc, 1 dc dec, 2 dc,
1 dc dec, 4 dc, 1 dc dec,
2 dc, 1 dc dec, 2 dc (16)
- 13.) 1 dc, 1 dc dec, 2 dc,
1 dc dec, 2 dc, 1 dc dec,
2 dc, 1 dc dec, 1 dc (12)
- 14.) 1 dc, 1 dc dec, 1 dc dec,
2 dc, 1 dc dec, 1 dc dec, 1 dc (8)

Stuff the head and sew the opening together.

EARS (2 X)

- 1.) cr with 4 dc (4)
- 2.) 2 dc in each st (8)
- 3.) *1 dc inc, 3 dc* (10)
4. - 6.) 10 dc (10)
- 7.) *1 dc dec, 3 dc* (8)
- 8.) 8 dc (8)

Use the yarn ends to sew the ears onto the head.

For the hair, cut lengths of yarn of approx. 12 cm.

Pull them through a stitch so that the yarn is double.

Tie knots and cut hair to make it look good.

NOSE

- 1.) cr with 6 dc (6)
- 2.) 2 dc in each st (12)
- 3.) *1 dc, 1 dc inc* (18)
- 4.) 18 dc (18)
- 5.) *1 dc, 1 dc dec* (12)

The nose is added in the middle of the centre ring.

As an alternative the nose may be embroidered on.

Use the yarn ends to sew the nose onto the head.

LEGS (4 X)

Begin with 'Little one's Cotton'.

- 1.) cr with 4 dc (4)
- 2.) 2 dc in each st (8)
- 3.) *1 dc, 1 dc inc* (12)
- 4.) *2 dc, 1 dc inc* (16)
- 5.) 16 dc (16)

Change to Curly.

6. - 7.) 16 dc (16)
- 8.) *6 dc, 1 dc dec* (14)
- 9.) *5 dc, 1 dc dec* (12)
10. - 16.) 12 dc (12)

Stuff the legs with fibrefill, sew the opening together and sew the legs onto the body.



Good to know

Needle Size & Tension

Knitters knit very differently: some knit with a needle size 2,0 mm and obtain the same size of design quality as a person who knits with a needle size 4,0 mm. We owe this knowledge to the team of knitters who join us.

The key to knit a specific size is a lot about the knitting style/hands/skills, rather than the size of needles.

Therefore, we will recommend a range of needle sizes.



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
