- 100 % Polyester 50g/ 65 m.



YARN USAGE

Bathing Bunnies H: 60 cm

Colour A: 100 g

Colour B: 50 g

*A few meters of white yarn
for stripes*

MATERIALS

Eyes: 12 mm, Filling

Crochet hook: 4,0 - 5,0 mm

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Filling

Eyes: 12 mm

Crochet hook: 4,0 - 5,0 mm

The given amounts of yarn are for guidance only.

REQUIRED MOUNTING STEPS

Eyes in yarn projects (0-3 years)

For projects for children 0-3 years:
Mounting of eyes requires melting of
end pieces and special stitching.

ABBREVIATIONS AND DEFINITIONS

st(s)	Stitch(es)
mr	Magic ring
ch	Chain stitch
t-ch	Turn chain stitch, 1 ch then turn the work
sl st	Slip stitch
dc	Double crochet
2 dc inc	Increase (2 dc in one st)
dc 2 tog	Decrease (2 dc worked together)
* ... *	The instructions shown in these brackets must be repeated for the whole round/row or with the number indicated after x.
(..)	At the end of the round/row - indicates the total number of stitches.

*If nothing else is specified, work in spiral rounds.
To finish the work, join the round with a sl st.
Leave a 20 cm length of yarn and cut. Pull the
yarn through the stitch.*

*It is recommended that the filling continues on an
ongoing basis as the work progresses.
Finish the whole work by assembling all parts
- ears on the head, and the head and arms on
the body.*

*For placements, look at the pictures in the
pattern, or as it will be natural on the finished
crochet work.*

BATHING BUNNY

H: 60 CM

LEGS (A & B, 2 X)

Begin with the colour of the shoes, B.

The first leg is finished off here.

Cut the yarn and pull the yarn through the stitch.

Second leg

Like the first leg, but don't cut the yarn.

BODY (A & B)

The body (swimsuit) can be crocheted in a solid colour or striped:

1. Solid color swimsuit

The body is worked as a continuation of the legs with the colour B.

2. Striped swimsuit

For a striped swimsuit, crochet rows 10, 13, 16, 19, 22 and 25 in white on the body, as shown in the pictures.

BATHING SHOES TIE-STRING (B, 2 X)

Chain of 38 ch (38)

Attach the tie-string as shown in the pictures.

SWIMSUIT STRAPS (B, 2 X)

Chain of 11 ch (11)

Attach the straps as shown in the pictures.

EARS (A, 2 X)

1.) cr with 6 dc (6)

2.) *1 dc, 2 dc inc* (9)

3.) 9 dc (9)

4.) *2 dc, 2 dc inc* (12)

5.) 12 dc (12)

6.) *3 dc, 2 dc inc* (15)

7.) 15 dc (15)

8.) *4 dc, 2 dc inc* (18)

9. - 14.) 18 dc (18)

15.) *4 dc, dc 2 tog* (15)

16.) 15 dc (15)

17.) *3 dc, dc 2 tog* (12)

18.) 12 dc (12)

19.) *4 dc, dc 2 tog* (10)

ARMS (A, 2 X)

1.) cr with 5 dc (5)

2.) *2 dc inc* (10)

3.) 2 dc inc, 9 dc (11)

4. - 29.) 11 dc (11)

30.) 4 dc, dc 2 tog, 5 dc (10)

31.) 1 t-ch, fold the arms flat
and work 5 dc (*shoulder*)
through both sides across the arms (5)

*Sew the arms onto the body so that the last 5 dc are
placed as the shoulder.*



Good to know

Hook Size + Tension

Crocheters crochet very differently: some crochet with a hook size 2,0 mm and obtain the same size of design and quality as a person who crochets with a hook size 4,0 mm. We owe this knowledge to the team of crocheters who join us. The key to crochet a specific size is a lot about the crochet style/hands/skills, rather than the size of hook. Therefore, we will recommend a range of hook sizes.



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
