Lady H 53 cm

Fur Lux 300 g

Tencel (crochet with 4 threads) 100 g

MATERIALER

Filling

Eyes: 16 mm

Nose: 16 mm

Crochet hook: 6,0 - 7,0 mm

Tencel: 40% Tencel/60% Bamboo, 50 g/210 m.*

Mounting of eyes requires melting of
end pieces and special stitching.

ABBREVIATIONS AND DEFINITIONS

st(s)	Stitch(es)
cr	Magic ring
ch	Chain stitch
t-ch	Turn chain stitch, ch 1 then turn the work
sl st	Slip stitch
dc	Double crochet
1 dc inc	Increase (2 dc in one st)
dc 2 tog	Decrease (2 dc worked together)
...	The instructions shown in these brackets must be repeated for the whole round/ row or with the number after x.
(..)	At the end of the round/row - indicates the total number of stitches.

If nothing else is specified, work in spiral rounds. To finish the work, join the round with a sl st. Leave a 20 cm length of yarn and cut. Pull the yarn through the stitch.

It is recommended that the filling continues on an ongoing basis as the work progresses.

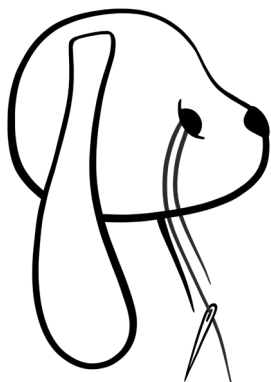
Add filling to the head

*Close the hole by pulling the remaining thread
through the 5 sts with a needle. Fasten the yarn ends.*

Shape the head and the eye sockets:

Thread the yarn a with approx. 25 cm yarn.

*Insert the needle under the chin and up by the inner
side of the eye. Stitch over one stitch and bring the
needle out at the lower part of the chin. Tighten the
thread so that the pressure creates a depression
above the eye. To maintain the pressure on the
depression, stitch through a couple of stitches at the
lower part of the chin. The depression on one eye is
now completed. Repeat the process on the opposite
eye. See illustration.*

EAR (2 X)

Here you crochet back and forth.

- 1.) Crochet 3 ch st, turn the work and start from the 2nd st from you hook. crochet 2 dc, 1 t-ch (2)
- 2.) 2 dc, 1 t-ch (2)
- 3.) *1 dc inc* x 2, 1 t-ch (4)
- 4.) *1 dc, 1 dc inc* x 2, 1 t-ch (6)
- 5.) *2 dc, 1 dc inc* x 2, 1 t-ch (8)
6. - 7.) 8 dc, 1 t-ch (8)
- 8.) *3 dc, 1 dc inc* x 2, 1 t-ch (10)
9. - 20.) 10 dc, 1 t-ch (10)
- 21.) *3 dc, 1 dc dec* x 2, 1 t-ch (8)
22. - 24.) 8 dc, 1 t-ch (8)
- 25.) *2 dc, 1 dc dec* x 2, 1 t-ch (6)
26. - 27.) 6 dc, 1 t-ch (6)
- 28.) *1 dc, 1 dc dec* x 2, 1 t-ch (4)

4.) 2 dc, 1 dc inc, 1 t-ch (4)

5.) 4 dc, 1 t-ch (4)

6.) *1 dc, 1 dc inc* x 2, 1 t-ch (6)

7.) *2 dc, 1 dc inc* x 2, 1 t-ch (8)

8. - 12.) 8 dc, 1 t-ch (8)

13.) 1 dc dec, 4 dc, 1 dc dec, 1 t-ch (6)

14. - 17.) 6 dc, 1 t-ch (6)

18.) 1 dc dec, 4 dc (5)

Good to know

Hook Size + Tension

Crocheters crochet very differently: some crochet with a hook size 2,0 mm and obtain the same size of design and quality as a person who crochets with a hook size 4,0 mm. We owe this knowledge to the team of crocheters who join us.

The key to crochet a specific size is a lot about the crochet style/hands/skills, rather than the size of hook. Therefore, we will recommend a range of hook sizes.



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
