Crocheted in Go handmades Soft Bamboo
"Double" - 70% Bamboo/23% Cotton/7%
Acrylic 50g/ 115 m.



Materials

Yarn Soft Bamboo "Double":

Bird 9 cm: 15 g

Bird 11 cm: 20 g

Heart 6 - 7 cm: 3 - 5 g

Bead 2,5 cm: 2 g

Yellow: 20 cm

Crochet hook 2,0 - 3,0 mm

Wooden beads 20 mm

Wooden ring 45 mm

Polyester string

Eyes 8 mm

Toy stuffing

LITTLE BIRD

15 g yarn Soft Bamboo "Double"
20 cm yellow yarn Soft Bamboo "Double"

BIG BIRD

20 g yarn Soft Bamboo "Double"
20 cm yellow yarn Soft Bamboo "Double"

BEADS

2 g yarn Soft Bamboo "Double"

BIG HEART

5 g yarn Soft Bamboo "Double"

LITTLE HEART

3 g yarn Soft Bamboo "Double"

Wooden beads 20 mm

Wooden ring 45 mm

Polyester string

Eyes 8 mm

Toy stuffing

Crochet hook size 2.0 - 3.0 mm

All yarn lengths are estimates and depend on crocheting style.

When making needlework and homemade items, especially for babies, please be cautious with assembling, particularly for knots and loops.

ABBREVIATIONS AND DEFINITIONS

st(s)	Stitch(es)
dc	Double crochet
dc 2 tog	Decrease (2 dc worked together)
{...} to end	The instructions shown in these brackets must be repeated for the whole round/row
(..)	At the end of the line - indicates the total number of stitches

REQUIRED MOUNTING STEPS

Eyes in yarn projects (0-3 years)

For projects for children 0-3 years:
Mounting of eyes requires melting of end pieces and special stitching.

LITTLE BIRD

BODY

1.)	6 dc in magic ring	(6)
2.)	{2 dc in each st}	(12)
3.)	{1 dc in next st, 2 dc in next st}	(18)
4.)	{2 dc, 2 dc in next st}	(24)
5.)	{3 dc, 2 dc in next st}	(30)
6.)	{4 dc, 2 dc in next st}	(36)
7 - 10.)	36 dc	(36)
11.)	{4 dc, dc 2 tog}	(30)
12.)	30 dc	(30)
13.)	{4 dc, 2 dc in next st}	(36)
14.)	{5 dc, 2 dc in next st}	(42)
15 - 19.)	42 dc	(42)

Attach the eyes between rounds 11 and 12 with 4 dc between.

20.)	{5 dc, dc 2 tog}	(36)
21.)	{4 dc, dc 2 tog}	(30)
22.)	{3 dc, dc 2 tog}	(24)

Begin to stuff.

23.)	{2 dc, dc 2 tog}	(18)
24.)	{1 dc, dc 2 tog}	(12)

Continue to stuff.

25.)	dc 2 tog x 6	(6)
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Bind off and leave a long thread end.

To close the body, weave thread end through all 6 dc in the front loops only then pull.

Embroider the beak.

Cut some thread ends of about 10 cm, and draw them through a stitch so that they are double. Make knots, and trim the hair.

WINGS (2 X)

1.)	6 dc in magic ring	(6)
2.)	{2 dc in each st}	(12)

3. - 4.)	12 dc	(12)
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5.)	4 dc, dc 2 tog x 2	(10)
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Bind off and leave long thread end for sewing.

TAIL

1.)	5 dc in magic ring	(5)
2.)	5 dc	(5)
3.)	{2 dc in each st}	(10)
4.)	10 dc	(10)

Bind off and leave long thread end for sewing.

BIG BIRD

BODY

1.)	6 dc in magic ring	(6)
2.)	{2 dc in each st}	(12)
3.)	{1 dc in next st, 2 dc in next st}	(18)
4.)	{2 dc, 2 dc in next st}	(24)
5.)	{3 dc, 2 dc in next st}	(30)
6.)	{4 dc, 2 dc in next st}	(36)
7.)	{11 dc, 2 dc in next st}	(39)
8. - 12.)	39 dc	(39)
13.)	{11 dc, dc 2 tog}	(36)
14.)	{10 dc, dc 2 tog}	(33)
15.)	33 dc	(33)
16.)	{10 dc, 2 dc in next st}	(36)
17.)	{5 dc, 2 dc in next st}	(42)
18.)	{6 dc, 2 dc in next st}	(48)
19. - 25.)	48 dc	(48)

Attach the eyes between rounds 13 and 14 with 6 dc between.

26.)	{6 dc, dc 2 tog}	(42)
27.)	{5 dc, dc 2 tog}	(36)
28.)	{4 dc, dc 2 tog}	(30)

29.) {3 dc, dc 2 tog} (24)

Begin to stuff.

30.) {2 dc, dc 2 tog} (18)

31.) {1 dc, dc 2 tog} (12)

Continue to stuff.

32.) dc 2 tog x 6 (6)

Bind off and leave a long thread end.

To close the body, weave thread end through all 6 dc in the front loops only then pull.

Embroider the beak.

Cut some thread ends of about 10 cm, and draw them through a stitch so that they are double. Make knots, and trim the hair.

WINGS (2 X)

1.) 6 dc in magic ring (6)

2.) {2 dc in each st} (12)

3. - 5.) 12 dc (12)

6.) 4 dc, dc 2 tog x 2 (10)

Bind off and leave long thread end for sewing.

TAIL

1.) 5 dc in magic ring (5)

2.) 5 dc (5)

3.) {2 dc in each st} (10)

4. - 5.) 10 dc (10)

Bind off and leave thread tail end for sewing.

BEADS

1.) 6 dc in magic ring (6)

2.) {2 dc in each st} (12)

3.) 1 dc, 2 dc in next st,
2 dc, 2 dc in next st,
2 dc, 2 dc in next st,
2 dc, 2 dc in next st, 1 dc (16)

4.) 3 dc, 2 dc in next st,
3 dc, 2 dc in next st,
3 dc, 2 dc in next st,
3 dc, 2 dc in next st (20)

5.) 4 dc, 2 dc in next st,
10 dc, 2 dc in next st, 4 dc (22)

6.) 22 dc (22)

7.) 4 dc, dc 2 tog, 10 dc,
dc 2 tog, 4 dc (20)

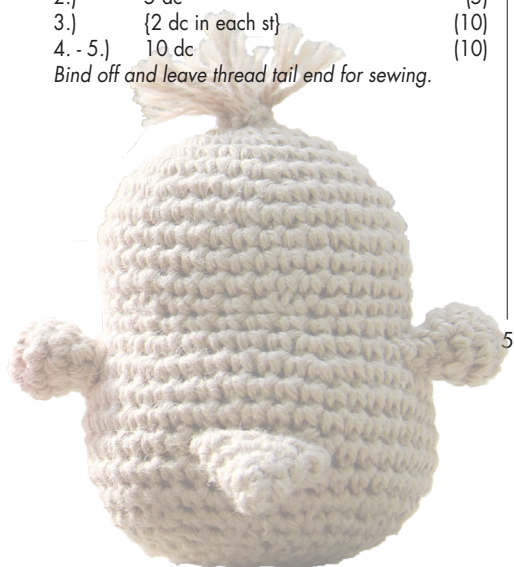
8.) dc 2 tog, 3 dc, dc 2 tog, 3 dc,
dc 2 tog, 3 dc, dc 2 tog, 3 dc (16)

9.) 1 dc, dc 2 tog, 2 dc, dc 2 tog,
2 dc, dc 2 tog, 2 dc, dc 2 tog, 1 dc (12)

10.) 6 x dc 2 tog (6)

Stuff and shape the beads.

Bind off.



BIG HEART

Beginning at the top of the heart, with magic ring:

First top (half of the heart)

Do **not** cut yarn.

Join with a slip stitch.

Beginning at the top of the heart, with magic ring:

First top (half of the heart)

Repeat the rounds 1. - 3.

Do **not** cut yarn.

Good to know

Go handmade's collection is developed and handcrafted by the expert hands of passionate crocheters. All are crocheted to meet what we find is a medium tightness and what suits the animal.

Hook Size + Tension

Crocheters crochet very differently: some crochet with a hook size 2,0 mm and obtain the same size of design and quality as a person who crochets with a hook size 4,0 mm. We owe this knowledge to the team of crocheters who join us. The key to crochet a specific size is a lot about the crochet style/hands/skills, rather than the size of hook. Therefore, we will recommend a range of hook sizes.
