

YARN USAGE

Small Bunny: 30 cm:

Colour A 150 g

Colour B 50 g

Large Bunny: 37 cm:

Colour A 200 g

Colour B 50 g

30 cm of black yarn

for nose and mouth

MATERIALS

Safety Eyes: 14 & 16 mm, Filling

Crochet hook: 3,5 - 4,0 mm

Gauge: 17 dc/10 cm

YARN USAGE

Small Bunny: 30 cm:

Colour A 150 g

Colour B 50 g

Large Bunny: 37 cm:

Colour A 200 g

Colour B 50 g

30 cm of black yarn for nose and mouth.

MATERIALS

Safety Eyes: 14 & 16 mm

Filling

Crochet hook: 3,5 - 4,0 mm

Gauge: 17 dc/10 cm

Stated yarn lengths are for guidance only.

If nothing else is specified, work in spiral rounds.

To finish the work, join the round with a sl st.

Leave a 20 cm length of yarn and cut. Pull the yarn through the stitch.

REQUIRED MOUNTING STEPS

Eyes in yarn projects (0-3 years)

For projects for children 0-3 years:

Mounting of eyes requires melting of end pieces and special stitching.

cr	Magic ring
ch	Chain stitch
sl st	Slip stitch
dc	Double crochet
1 dc inc	Increase (2 dc into 1 st)
dc 2 tog	Decrease (2 dc worked together)
* ... *	The instructions shown in these brackets must be repeated for the whole round/row with the number indicated after x.
(..)	At the end of the line - indicates the total number of stitches.

When making needlework and homemade items, especially for babies, please be cautious with assembling, particularly for eyes, knots and loops.

Fill with filling.

Cut the yarn, pull the thread through the stitches, tighten and sew the head closed.

Shape eye socket/head:

With Bohème Velvet "double" yarn, thread a needle with approx. 25 cm yarn.

Put the needle in from the base of the head and out at the inner side of the eye.

Guide the thread across a couple of stitches by the eye and then back out at the base of the head. Tighten the yarn to form the hollow around the eye.

To keep the pressure on the hollow, sew through a couple of sts at the base of the head.



Fasten the yarn ends.

Should you want the hollow deeper the process may be repeated.

Repeat for the other side of the same eye.

The eye sockets are now made for both eyes.

Embroider nose with a shape like the letter "Y".

Fill with filling as you go.

Cut the yarn, pull the thread through the stitches, tighten and sew the head closed.

Shape eye socket/head:

With Bohème Velvet "double" yarn, thread a needle with approx. 25 cm yarn.

Put the needle in from the base of the head and out at the inner side of the eye.

Guide the thread across a couple of stitches by the

eye and then back out at the base of the head. Tighten the yarn to form the hollow around the eye.

To keep the pressure on the hollow, sew through a couple of sts at the base of the head.

Fasten the yarn ends.

5 dc in ch on the opposite side,
2 dc in the final ch (19)
- 2.) 1 dc inc, 7 dc, 1 dc inc x 3,
7 dc, 1 dc inc (24)
- 3.) 1 dc inc x 2, 8 dc, 1 dc inc x 5,
8 dc, 1 dc inc (32)
- 4.) 1 dc inc x 3, 11 dc, 1 dc inc x 5,
12 dc, 1 dc inc (41)

Switch to Colour A.

Good to know

Hook Size + Tension

Crocheters crochet very differently: some crochet with a hook size 2,0 mm and obtain the same size of design and quality as a person who crochets with a hook size 4,0 mm. We owe this knowledge to the team of crocheters who join us.

The key to crochet a specific size is a lot about the crochet style/hands/skills, rather than the size of hook. Therefore, we will recommend a range of hook sizes.
