Pattern

COCO on cosy blanket and wooden ring



Crocheted in Go handmades Teddy: 100% Polyester, 50 g/65 m and Go handmades 'Little one's Cotton': 100% Cotton, 50 g/155 m.

Materials

Cosy blanket 22 x 22 cm Coco on wooden ring 12 cm

Teddy yarn: 100 g 'Little one's Cotton' yarn: 50 g

Crochet hook 2,0-3,0 mm
Crochet hook cosy blanket: 4,0-5,0 mm
Wooden ring: 68 mm
Nose: 12 mm
Eyes: 7 mm

COCO - ON COSY BLANKET

15 g brown Go Handmade Little one's Cotton 75 g dark brown Go Handmade Teddy yarn Stuffing 2 eyes 7 mm

Nose 12 mm

Crochet hook size 2,0 - 3,0 mm

Crochet hook size 4,0 - 5,0 mm (for the blanket)

COCO - ON WOODEN RING

15 g brown Go Handmade Little one's Cotton 15 g dark brown Go Handmade Teddy yarn Stuffing 2 eyes 7 mm Nose 12 mm

Wooden ring 68 mm

Crochet hook size 2,0 - 3,0 mm

COCO - PÅ MOBILE (1)

7 g brown Go Handmade Little one's Cotton 7 g dark brown Go Handmade Teddy yarn Stuffing

2 eyes 7 mm Nose 12 mm

Crochet hook size 2,0 - 3,0 mm

All yarn lengths are estimates and depend on crocheting style.

Eyes in yarn projects (0-3 years)

For projects for children 0-3 years: Mounting of eyes requires melting of end pieces and special stitching.

COCO - ON COSY BLANKET

HEAD

Crochet with Little one's cotton.

1.)	cr with 6 dc	(6)
2.)	{2 dc in each st}	(12)
3.)	{1 dc in next st, 2 dc in next st}	(18)
4.)	{2 dc, 2 dc in next st}	(24)
5.)	{3 dc, 2 dc in next st}	(30)
6.)	{4 dc, 2 dc in next st}	(36)
7.)	{5 dc, 2 dc in next st}	(42)
8 14.)	{42 dc}	(42)

Insert the eyes between rows 12 & 13 with a distance of 6 sts in between.

The discs for the eyes are inserted from the inside, push them firmly, perhaps by using a coin.

15.)	{5 dc, dc 2 tog}	(36)
16.)	{4 dc, dc 2 tog}	(30)
1 <i>7</i> .)	{3 dc, dc 2 tog}	(24)

Begin to stuff.

18.)	{2 dc, dc 2 tog}	(18)
19.)	{1 dc, dc 2 tog}	(12)
20.)	{dc 2 tog}	(6)

Fill the head with toy stuffing.

Close the hole by pulling the yarn with a darning needle through the 6 sts.

Use the yarn end to sew the head onto the blanket. Pull a piece of yarn from the bottom of the head (the part where the blanket will be attached) up until just under one eye.

Guide the thread around 1 st and back in.

Pull both parts of this string tightly in order to form an eye hole.

Attach both ends with a knot. Repeat for the other eye.

Weave in the ends.

SNOUT

Crochet with Little one's cotton.

- 1.) Work 5 ch, 2 dc into the 2nd ch from the hook, 2 dc, 3 dc into the last ch. Continue on the other side of the length of 3 dc (10)
- 2.) 1 dc, 2 dc in next st, 2 dc, 2 dc in next st, 1 dc, 2 dc in next st, 2 dc, 2 dc in next st (14)
- 3.) 2 dc, 2 dc in next st, 3 dc, 2 dc in next st, 2 dc, 2 dc in next st, 3 dc, 2 dc in next st (18)
- 4.) 2 dc in next st, 8 dc, 2 dc in next st, 8 dc (20)

Attach the nose in the midle of the snout.

The discs for the nose are inserted from the inside, push them firmly, perhaps by using a coin. Fill the snout with toy stuffing.

Use the yarn end to sew the snout onto the head.

EARS (2 X

Start with Little one's cotton.

Do **not** close the ring.

Turn your work, crochet in rows from here on.
2.) {1 ch, 2 dc in each st}

{1 ch, 2 dc in each st}
 Change to Teddy yarn.
 {1 ch, {1 dc in next st,

2 dc in next st) }

Use the yarn end to sew the ears onto the head.

ARMS (2 X)

Crochet with Little one's cotton.

1.)	cr with 6 dc	(6)
2.)	{2 dc in each st}	(12)
3 5.)	12 dc	(12)
6.)	{2 dc, dc 2 tog}	(9)
7 11.)	9 dc	(9)
12.)	7 dc, dc 2 tog	(8)
13.)	8 dc	(8)
14.)	6 dc, dc 2 tog	(7)
15.)	7 dc	(7)

Fill the arms with toy stuffing.
Use the yarn end to sew the arms onto the blanket.

COSY BLANKET

Crochet with Teddy yarn.

The cosy blanket is crocheted like a grandmother's square as follows.

Each round starts with 3 ch, which replaces the 1st tr. Finish with 1 sl st in 3rd ch in the start of the round.

- 1.) cr, {3 tr, 2 ch} i the ring x 4
- 2.) {3 tr, 2 ch, 3 tr, 2 ch} in each corner x 4
- 3.) 3 sl st to the corner.
 - {3 tr, 2 ch, 3 tr, 2 ch in the corner group.
 - 3 tr, 2 ch in the ch-loop} x 4
- 4. 8.) Crochet as round 3, which increases with 1 tr-group + 2 ch in the ch-loops

Continue to the desired size.

In this recipe there are 8 rounds with approx. dimensions of 22 x 22 cm.

Weave in the ends.

Insert the eyes between rows 12 & 13 with a distance of 6 sts in between.

Beain to stuff.

18.)	{2 dc, dc 2 tog}	(18)
19.)	{1 dc, dc 2 tog}	(12)
20.)	{dc 2 tog}	(6)

The head is made the same way as the head on 'cosy blanket'.

SNOUT

Crochet with Little one's cotton

1.) Work 5 ch, 2 dc into the 2nd ch from the hook, 2 dc, 3 dc into the last ch. Continue on the other side of the length of 3 dc

2.) 1 dc, 2 dc in next st, 2 dc, 2 dc in next st,

1 dc, 2 dc in next st, 2 dc, 2 dc in next st

RING-COVER

Crochet with Little one's cotton.

1.)	21 ch, turn the work	(21)
	- 1 - 1 1 6 1 1 1	

2.) 1 dc in 2nd ch from the hook, crochet 20 dc till the end, turn the work

3. - 11.) 1 ch, crochet 20 dc till the end.

Turn the work after each row (20)

Sew the cover onto the wooden ring with the yarn end. Sew the head onto the ring.

Crochet with Little one's cotton

2.)	{2 dc in each st}	(12)
3 5.)	12 dc	(12)
6.)	{2 dc, dc 2 tog}	(9)
7 11.)	9 dc	(9)

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Fill the arms with toy stuffing.

Use the yarn end to sew the arms onto the ring.

In the same way as the ears on 'cosy blanket'.

SCARF

Crochet with Teddy yarn.

1.) Work 25 ch, turn the work and make 24 dc

Fasten it on the head.

Hook Size & Tension

Crocheters crochet very differently: some crochet with a hook size 2,0 mm and obtain the same size of design and quality as a person who crochets with a hook size 4,0 mm. We owe this knowledge to the team of crocheters who join us. The key to crochet a specific size is a lot about the crochet style/hands/skills, rather than the size of hook. Therefore, we will recommend a range of hook sizes.



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
