Crochet hook (Couture): 3,0 - 4,0 mm Crochet hook (Vintage): 3,0 - 4,0 mm

Gauge: Coture: Firm Vintage: 24 dc/10 cm

The given amounts are for guidance only.

REQUIRED MOUNTING STEPS

Eyes in yarn projects (0-3 years)

For projects for children 0-3 years: Mounting of eyes requires melting of end pieces and special stitching.



Shape the head and the eye hollows:

and sew the head together.

With Vintage yarn, thread a needle with approx. 25 cm yarn. Put the needle in from under the chin and out at the side of the eye.

Cut the yarn and pull through the stitches, tighten


Guide the thread around some stitches by the eye and then back out under the chin. Tighten the yarn to form the hollow around the eye, tighten the yarn through a few stitches under the chin.

Repeat for the other side of the same eye.
The hollow for the eye is now completed. Should you want the hollow deeper the process can be repeated and a stitch added towards the top of the eye.
Repeat the process for the other eye.

Embroider nose/mouth as an upside down "Y".

Sew the head onto the body.



EAR (2 X)

Work with Vintage Yarn. mr with 6 dc 1.) (6)2.) *1 dc, 1 dc inc* (9) *2 dc, 1 dc inc* 3.1 (12)*3 dc, 1 dc inc* 4.) (15)*4 dc, 1 dc inc* 5.) (18)

Good to know

Hook Size & Tension

Crocheters crochet very differently: some crochet with a hook size 2,0 mm and obtain the same size of design and quality as a person who crochets with a hook size 4,0 mm. We owe this knowledge to the team of crocheters who join us. The key to crochet a specific size is a lot about the crochet style/hands/skills, rather than the size of hook. Therefore, we will recommend a range of hook sizes.



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
