YARN USAGE

Happy Bears H 40 cm

Colour A Bohème Velvet "double": 200 g

Colour B Bohème Velvet "double": 50 g

*A few meters of black yarn
for nose and mouth.*

MATERIALS

Eyes: 14 mm, Filling

Crochet hook: 4,0 - 5,0 mm

Gauge: 18 dc/10 cm

YARN USAGE

Colour A Bohème Velvet "double" 200 g
Colour B Bohème Velvet "double" 50 g
A few meters of black yarn for nose and mouth.

MATERIALS:

Eyes: 14 mm
Filling
Crochet hook: 4,0 - 5,0 mm

Gauge: 18 dc/10 cm

The given amounts of yarn are for guidance only.

If nothing else is specified, work in spiral rounds.
To finish the work, join the round with a sl st.
Leave a 20 cm length of yarn and cut. Pull the
yarn through the stitch.

It is recommended that the filling continues on an ongoing basis as the work progresses.

REQUIRED MOUNTING STEPS

Eyes in yarn projects (0-3 years)

For projects for children 0-3 years:
Mounting of eyes requires melting of
end pieces and special stitching.

The eyes are inserted approx. between rows 12 - 13.

Stuff the head with filling.

Cut the yarn and pull through the stitches, tighten and sew the head together leaving a small opening.

Shape the head and the eye sockets:

Pull a thread from the opening of the head (the part that will be sewn onto the body) to the place of one eye, guide the thread around a stitch and back.

Tighten to form the eye deepening, attach the thread with a knot. Repeat for the other eye.



Close the last opening.

SNOUT (B)

Crochet with Bohème Velvet "double" colour B.

1.)	cr with 6 dc	(6)
2.)	*2 dc inc*	(12)
3.)	*1 dc, 2 dc inc*	(18)
4.)	*2 dc, 2 dc inc*	(24)
5.)	*3 dc, 2 dc inc*	(30)
6. - 9.)	30 dc	(30)

Add stuffing into the snout and sew onto the head.
Embroider nose and mouth as shown in the pictures.

EARS (A, 2 X)

Crochet with Bohème Velvet "double" colour A.

The ears are sewn to the head as shown in the pictures.
Sew the head to the body when all parts have been attached.

Crochet with Bohème Velvet "double" colour B.

1.)	Chain 8, 2 dc in 2nd ch from hook, 5 dc, 5 dc in the final ch, 5 dc in ch on the opposite side, 2 dc in the final ch	(19)
2.)	2 dc inc, 7 dc, 3 x 2 dc inc, 7 dc, 2 dc inc	(24)
3.)	2 x 2 dc inc, 8 dc, 5 x 2 dc inc, 8 dc, 2 dc inc	(32)
4.)	3 x 2 dc inc, 11 dc, 5 x 2 dc inc, 12 dc, 2 dc inc	(41)

Change to Bohème Velvet "double" colour A.

Good to know

Hook Size & Tension

Crocheters crochet very differently: some crochet with a hook size 2,0 mm and obtain the same size of design and quality as a person who crochets with a hook size 4,0 mm. We owe this knowledge to the team of crocheters who join us. The key to crochet a specific size is a lot about the crochet style/hands/skills, rather than the size of hook. Therefore, we will recommend a range of hook sizes.
