Squeakers 2 pcs.: 25 mm

Filling

Crochet hook: 2,5 - 3,0 mm

Gauge: 28 sts/10 cm

## YARN USAGE

Teddy H 26 cm

Yarn: 70 g

## MATERIALS

Eyes: 10 mm

Wooden ring: 55 mm

Rattle cellophane

Soft TPE Heart

Rattle boxes 2 pcs.: 22 mm

Squeakers 2 pcs.: 25 mm

Filling

Crochet hook: 3,0 mm

Gauge: 28 dc/10 cm

*The given amounts of yarn are for guidance only.*

st(s)	Stitch(es)
mr	Magic ring
sl st	Slip stitch
ch	Chain stitch
t-ch	Crochet 1 ch, turn work
dc	Double crochet
1 dc inc	Increase (2 dc in one st)
2 dc tog	Decrease (2 dc worked together)
* ... *	The instructions shown between these stars must be repeated for the whole round/row or with the number indicated after x.
(..)	At the end of the round/row
-	indicates the total number of stitches.

## REQUIRED MOUNTING STEPS

### Eyes in yarn projects (0-3 years)

For projects for children 0-3 years:  
Mounting of eyes requires melting of end pieces and special stitching.

### Strap for pendant - size: L 8 cm x W 1 cm:

- 1.) 26 ch, turn.
- 2.) 25 dc, start in 2nd ch from hook, 1 t-ch
- 3.) 25 dc.

*Break the yarn, add the Soft TPE Heart or Wooden ring, and sew on the body.*

Add Filling into the head.

Cut the yarn and pull through the stitches, tighten and sew the head together.

### Shape the eye sockets:

Thread a needle with approx. 25 cm yarn.

Put the needle in from under the chin and out at the side of the eye.

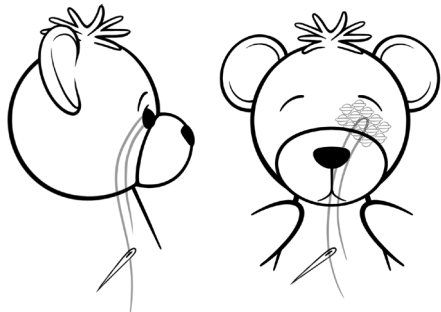
Guide the thread around some stitches by the eye and then back out under the chin. Tighten the yarn to form the hollow around the eye, tighten the yarn through a few stitches under the chin.

The hollow for the eye is now completed.

Should you want the hollow deeper the process can be repeated and a stitch added towards the top of the eye.

Repeat the process for the other eye.

See illustration.



Make 10 cm long strips of the yarn and pull them through a st so that they are double. Tie a knot and use scissors to style the hair.

Sew on eyebrows using the black yarn.

## SNOUT

- 1.) Crochet 7 ch. 2 dc in the 2. ch from the hook, 4 dc, 3 dc in the last ch. Continue back again on the opposite side of the chain row: 5 dc (14)

Add a thread as marker

- 2.) 1 dc inc, 2 dc, 1 dc inc x 2, 2 dc, 1 dc inc, 6 dc (18)

- 3.) 1 dc inc x 2, 3 dc, 1 dc inc x 2, 3 dc, 1 dc inc x 2, 6 dc (24)

- 4.) 1 dc, 1 dc inc x 2, 5 dc, 1 dc inc x 2, 5 dc, 1 dc inc x 2, 7 dc (30)

- 5.) 1 dc, 1 dc inc x 2, 7 dc, 1 dc inc x 2, 7 dc, 1 dc inc x 2, 9 dc (36)

- 6.) 36 dc (36)

- 7.) 12 dc, 2 dc tog x 2, 20 dc (34)

- 8.) 34 dc (34)

Close with a sl st.

Add filler to the snout.

Use the yarn end to sew the snout to the head.

Embroider on the mouth and snout (see drawing).

## EARS 2 X

- 1.) mr with 6 dc (6)  
 2.) \*2 dc inc\* (12)  
 3.) \*1 dc, 2 dc inc\* (18)  
 4.) \*2 dc, 2 dc inc\* (24)  
 5.) \*3 dc, 2 dc inc\* (30)  
 6.) 30 dc (30)  
 7.) \*3 dc, dc 2 tog\* (24)  
 8.) \*2 dc, dc 2 tog\* (18)  
 9.) \*1 dc, dc 2 tog\* (12)

Add 2 layers of Rattle cellophane to the ears.

Cast off and use the yarn end to sew the ears to the head.

## ARMS 2 X

- 1.) mr with 6 dc (6)  
 2.) \*1 dc inc\* (12)  
 3.) \*1 dc, 1 dc inc\* (18)  
 4.) \*2 dc, 1 dc inc\* (24)  
 5.) \*3 dc, 1 dc inc\* (30)  
 6.) \*4 dc, 1 dc inc\* (36)  
 7. - 8.) 36 dc (36)  
 9.) \*4 dc, 2 dc tog\* (30)  
 10. - 11.) 30 dc (30)  
 12.) \*3 dc, 2 dc tog\* (24)  
 13.) 24 dc (24)  
 14.) \*2 dc, 2 dc tog\* (18)  
 15. - 30.) 18 dc (18)  
 31.) \*1 dc, 2 dc tog\* (12)  
 32.) \*2 dc tog\* (6)

Insert the Squeakers and Filling into the arms.

Sew the arms to the body.

- 1.) Chain 8, 2 dc in 2nd ch from hook,  
5 dc, 5 dc in the final ch,  
5 dc in ch on the opposite side,  
2 dc in the final ch (19)
- 2.) 1 dc inc, 7 dc, 1 dc inc x 3,  
7 dc, 1 dc inc (24)
- 3.) 1 dc inc x 2, 8 dc, 1 dc inc x 5,  
8 dc, 1 dc inc (32)
- 4.) 1 dc inc x 3, 11 dc, 1 dc inc x 5,  
12 dc, 1 dc inc (41)
5. - 6.) 41 dc (41)
- 7.) 1 dc in the back loop of each dc (41)
- 8.) 18 dc, 2 dc tog x 4, 15 dc (37)
- 9.) 2 dc tog x 2, 13 dc,  
2 dc tog x 3, 14 dc (32)
- 10.) 14 dc, 2 dc tog, 1 dc, 2 dc tog, 13 dc (30)
- 11.) 2 dc tog, 10 dc, 2 dc tog x 3,  
10 dc, 2 dc tog (25)
- 12.) 9 dc, 2 dc tog, 3 dc, 2 dc tog, 9 dc (23)
13. - 17.) 23 dc (23)
- 18.) 6 dc, 2 dc tog, 4 dc, 2 dc tog,

*Sew the legs to the body.*

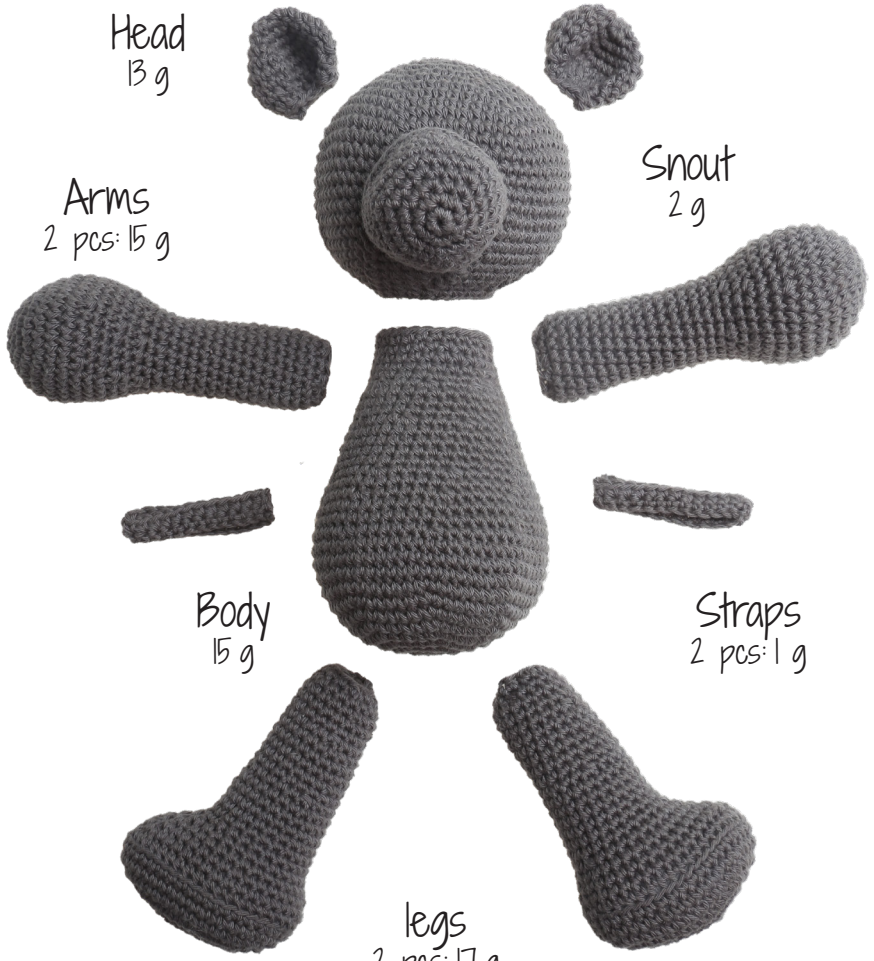

# Good to know

## Hook Size + Tension

Crocheters crochet very differently: some crochet with a hook size 2,0 mm and obtain the same size of design and quality as a person who crochets with a hook size 4,0 mm. We owe this knowledge to the team of crocheters who join us.

The key to crochet a specific size is a lot about the crochet style/hands/skills, rather than the size of hook. Therefore, we will recommend a range of hook sizes.



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
