YARN USAGE

Colour A	30 g
Colour B	30 g

MATERIALS

Eyes: 2 pair 8 mm
Squeaker: 1 pcs 25 mm
Rattle ball: 2 pcs D24 mm
TPE ring: 1 pcs D75 mm
Filling
Crochet hook: 2.5-3.0 mm
Gauge: 26 dc/ 10 cm

TPE ring: D75 mm

REQUIRED MOUNTING STEPS

Eyes in yarn projects (0-3 years)

For projects for children 0-3 years:
Mounting of eyes requires melting of end pieces and special stitching.

ABBREVIATIONS AND DEFINITIONS

st	Stitch
mr	Magic ring
ch	Chain stitch
dc	Double crochet
fl	Front loop
bl	Back loop
t-ch	Turn chain stitch, ch 1 then turn the work
2 dc inc	Increase (2 dc in one st)
dc 2 tog	Decrease (2 dc worked together)
...	The instructions shown between these stars must be repeated for the whole round/row or with the number indicated after x.
(..)	At the end of the round/row - indicates the total number of stitches.

11.)	*3 dc, dc 2 tog*	(24)
12 - 16.)	24 dc	(24)
17.)	*6 dc, dc 2 tog*	(21)
18 - 22.)	21dc	(21)

23.) *5 dc, dc 2 tog* (18)

24 - 30.) 18 dc (18)

Add filling and squeaker.

Cut the yarn and finish.

RUFFLE

The ruffle is crocheted directly from the holder.

Colour B

1.) *2 dc inc in fl* (36)

2.) *1 dc, 2 dc inc* (54)

3.) *2 dc, 2 dc inc* (72)

Cut the yarn and finish.

HEAD

Colour B

1.) Crocheted in the bl in row 1 on the ruffle:

2 dc, 2 dc inc (24)

2.) *3 dc, 2 dc inc* (30)

3.) *4 dc, 2 dc inc* (36)

4.) *5 dc, 2 dc inc* (42)

5. - 12.) 42 dc (42)

Place the eyes after rnd 8 with 7 sts in between.

13.) *5 dc, dc 2 tog* (36)

14.) *4 dc, dc 2 tog* (30)

15.) *3 dc, dc 2 tog* (24)

16.) *2 dc, dc 2 tog* (18)

17.) *1 dc, dc 2 tog* (12)

18.) *dc 2 tog* (6)

Add filling and squeaker.

Cut the yarn and finish.

Embroider the nose with colour B between the 6th - 8th round over 2 stitches.

EARS X 2

Cut the yarn 20 cm from the work.

Fold the ear in half and sew the end of the ear together with 2 stitches.

The ears are sewn onto the head after the 15th round.

Place the eyes after rnd 8 with 7 sts in between.

Embroider the nose with colour B between the 6th - 8th round over 2 stitches.

Cut the yarn 20 cm from the work.

Fold the ear in half and sew the end of the ear together with 2 stitches.

The ears are sewn onto the head after the 15th round.

COLLAR FOR RING

The collar is sewn around the ring.

The head is sewn onto the collar.

Good to know

Crochet hook size + Tension

Crocheters crochet very differently: some crochet with a hook size 2,0 mm and obtain the same size of design and quality as a person who crochets with a hook size 4,0 mm. We owe this knowledge to the team of crocheters who join us.

The key to crochet a specific size is a lot about the crochet style/hands/skills, rather than the size of hook. Therefore, we will recommend a range of hook sizes.



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
