YARN USAGE

Teddy H 23 cm

Colour A: 100 g

Colour B: 50 g

Black: few meters

MATERIALS

Eyes: 8 mm, Filling

Wooden ring: 55 mm

Rattle cellophane

Squeakers 2 pcs.: 25 mm

TPE Figure "Heart"

Rattle boxes 2 pcs.: 22 mm

Crochet hook: 3,0 - 3,5 mm

Gauge: 28 sts/10 cm

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The given amounts of yarn are for guidance only.

If nothing else is specified, work in spiral rounds.
To finish the work, join the round with a sl st.
Leave a 20 cm length of yarn and cut. Pull the yarn through the stitch..

REQUIRED MOUNTING STEPS

Eyes in yarn projects (0-3 years)

For projects for children 0-3 years:
Mounting of eyes requires melting of end pieces and special stitching.

ABBREVIATIONS AND DEFINITIONS

st(s)	Stitch(es)
mr	Magic ring
sl st	Slip stitch
ch	Chain stitch
t-ch	Crochet 1 ch, turn work
dc	Double crochet
1 dc inc	Increase (2 dc in one st)
2 dc tog	Decrease (2 dc worked together)
* ... *	The instructions shown between these stars must be repeated for the whole round/row or with the number indicated after x.
(..)	At the end of the round/row
-	indicates the total number of stitches.

When making handicrafts and homemade things for babies, it is important to be careful with the assembly/mounting of the parts. It is particularly necessary to be careful with knots and loops.

Strap for pendant - size: L 8 cm x W 1 cm:

- 1.) 26 ch, turn.
- 2.) 25 dc, start in 2nd ch from hook, 1 t-st
- 3.) 25 dc.

Break the yarn, add the Teething ring "Heart" or Wooden ring, and sew on the body.

Fill the body.

HEAD (COLOUR A)

1.)	mr with 6 dc	(6)

Place the eyes between rounds 14 and 15.

26.) *2 dc tog* (30)

27.) *3 dc, 2 dc tog* (24)

Add Filling into the head.


Cut the yarn and pull through the stitches, tighten and sew the head together.

Shape the head and the eye sockets:

Thread the yarn a with approx. 25 cm yarn.

Insert the needle under the chin and up by the inner side of the eye. Stitch over one stitch and bring the needle out at the lower part of the chin. Tighten the thread so that the pressure creates a depression above the eye. To maintain the pressure on the depression, stitch through a couple of stitches at the lower part of the chin. The depression on one eye is now completed. Repeat the process on the opposite eye.

STRENGTHEN AND SHAPE THE AREA AROUND THE EYES

Make 10 cm long strips of the yarn and pull them through a st so that they are double. Tie a knot and use scissors to style the hair.
Sew on eyebrows using the black yarn.

SNOUT (COLOUR B)

- 1.) Crochet 7 ch. 2 dc in the 2. ch from the hook, 4 dc, 3 dc in the last ch. Continue back again on the opposite side of the chain row: 5 dc (14)

Add a thread as marker

- 2.) 1 dc inc, 2 dc, 1 dc inc x 2, 2 dc, 1 dc inc, 6 dc (18)
- 3.) 1 dc inc x 2, 3 dc, 1 dc inc x 2, 3 dc, 1 dc inc x 2, 6 dc (24)
- 4.) 1 dc, 1 dc inc x 2, 5 dc, 1 dc inc x 2, 5 dc, 1 dc inc x 2, 7 dc (30)
- 5.) 1 dc, 1 dc inc x 2, 7 dc, 1 dc inc x 2, 7 dc, 1 dc inc x 2, 9 dc (36)
- 6.) 36 dc (36)
- 7.) 12 dc, 2 dc tog x 2, 20 dc (34)
- 8.) 34 dc (34)

Close with a sl st.

Add filler to the snout.

Use the yarn end to sew the snout to the head.

Embroider on the mouth and snout (see drawing).

EARS (COLOUR A, 2 X & B, 2 X)

- 1.) mr with 5 dc (8)

Turn the centre ring.

From here, you crochet back and forth.

- 2.) t-ch, *1 dc inc* (10)
- 3.) t-ch, *1 dc, 1 dc inc* (15)
- 4.) t-ch, *2 dc, 1 dc inc* (20)

Hold the two parts against each other (one of each colour), back to back and with colour A crochet them together.

5.) t-ch, 20 dc (20)

Add Rattle cellophane to the ears.

Cast off and use the yarn end to sew the ears to the head.

ARMS (COLOUR A, 2 X)

- 1.) mr with 6 dc (6)
- 2.) *1 dc inc* (12)
- 3.) *1 dc, 1 dc inc* (18)
- 4.) *2 dc, 1 dc inc* (24)
- 5.) *3 dc, 1 dc inc* (30)
- 6.) *4 dc, 1 dc inc* (36)
- 7. - 8.) 36 dc (36)
- 9.) *4 dc, 2 dc tog* (30)
- 10. - 11.) 30 dc (30)
- 12.) *3 dc, 2 dc tog* (24)
- 13.) 24 dc (24)
- 14.) *2 dc, 2 dc tog* (18)
- 15. - 30.) 18 dc (18)
- 31.) *1 dc, 2 dc tog* (12)
- 32.) *2 dc tog* (6)

Insert the Squeakers and Filling into the arms.

Sew the arms to the body.

LEGS (COLOUR A, 2 X)

- 1.) Chain 8, 2 dc in 2nd ch from hook, 5 dc, 5 dc in the final ch, 5 dc in ch on the opposite side, 2 dc in the final ch (19)
- 2.) 1 dc inc, 7 dc, 1 dc inc x 3, 7 dc, 1 dc inc (24)
- 3.) 1 dc inc x 2, 8 dc, 1 dc inc x 5, 8 dc, 1 dc inc (32)

- 4.) 1 dc inc x 3, 11 dc, 1 dc inc x 5, 12 dc, 1 dc inc (41)
- 5. - 6.) 41 dc (41)
- 7.) 1 dc in the back loop of each dc (41)
- 8.) 18 dc, 2 dc tog x 4, 15 dc (37)
- 9.) 2 dc tog x 2, 13 dc, 2 dc tog x 3, 14 dc (32)
- 10.) 14 dc, 2 dc tog, 1 dc, 2 dc tog, 13 dc (30)
- 11.) 2 dc tog, 10 dc, 2 dc tog x 3, 10 dc, 2 dc tog (25)
- 12.) 9 dc, 2 dc tog, 3 dc, 2 dc tog, 9 dc (23)
- 13. - 17.) 23 dc (23)
- 18.) 6 dc, 2 dc tog, 4 dc, 2 dc tog, 5 dc, 2 dc tog, 2 dc (20)
- 19. - 23.) 20 dc (20)
- 24.) 7 dc, 2 dc tog, 7 dc, 2 dc tog, 2 dc (18)
- 25. - 27.) 18 dc (18)
- 28.) 3 dc, 2 dc tog, 8 dc, 2 dc tog, 3 dc (16)
- 29.) *1 dc, 2 dc tog* x 5, finish with 1 dc (11)
- 30.) 2 dc tog x 5, 1 dc (6)

Insert the Rattle boxes and Filling into the legs.

Sew the legs to the body.



Good to know

Hook Size + Tension

Crocheters crochet very differently: some crochet with a hook size 2,0 mm and obtain the same size of design and quality as a person who crochets with a hook size 4,0 mm. We owe this knowledge to the team of crocheters who join us.

The key to crochet a specific size is a lot about the crochet style/hands/skills, rather than the size of hook. Therefore, we will recommend a range of hook sizes.



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
