- 100 % Polyester 50g/ 65 m



## YARN USAGE

Teddy H 40 cm: 250 g  
*A few meters of black yarn  
for mouth, nose  
and eyebrows.*

## MATERIALS

Filling  
Eyes: 14 mm  
Crochet hook: 3,0 - 3,5 mm

## YARN USAGE:

**Teddy H 40 cm: 250 g**

*A few meters of black yarn for mouth, snout and eyebrows.*

## MATERIALS:

Eyes: 14 mm

Filling

Crochet hook: 3,0 - 3,5 mm

*The given amounts of yarn are for guidance only.*

If nothing else is specified, work in spiral rounds. To finish the work, join the round with a sl st. Leave a 20 cm length of yarn and cut. Pull the yarn through the stitch.

*It is recommended that the filling continues on an ongoing basis as the work progresses.*

## REQUIRED MOUNTING STEPS

### Eyes in yarn projects (0-3 years)

For projects for children 0-3 years:  
Mounting of eyes requires melting of end pieces and special stitching.

## ABBREVIATIONS AND DEFINITIONS

st(s)	Stitch(es)
cr	Magic ring
ch	Chain stitch
t-ch	Turn chain stitch, 1 ch then turn the work
sl st	Slip stitch
dc	Double crochet
2 dc inc	Increase (2 dc in one st)
dc 2 tog	Decrease (2 dc worked together)
*...*	The instructions shown in these brackets must be repeated for the whole round/row or with the number after x.
(..)	At the end of the line - indicates the total number of stitches.

A "fluffy" yarn, that doesn't require any special techniques or stitches to get a nice and chunky result. Use Teddy for cuddle animals to give them a real "teddy" look or knit/crochet a blanket for babies/toddlers.

Teddy has been awarded the AZO certificate and is thus a yarn that everyone can feel safe wearing.

100% Polyester,

9.)	*7 dc, 2 dc inc*	(54)
10.)	*8 dc, 2 dc inc*	(60)
11. - 16.)	60 dc	(60)
17.)	*8 dc, dc 2 tog*	(54)

*Add the eyes after round 46, you should have 8 st between the eyes.*

*The stoppers of the eyes should be added from the inside, you could use a coin to press them on.*

*Add filler to the lower part of the head.*

57.) \*3 dc, dc 2 tog\* (24)

58.) \*2 dc, dc 2 tog\* (18)

59.) \*1 dc, dc 2 tog\* (12)

60.) \*dc 2 tog\* (6)

*Stuff the rest of the head with filler.*

*Close with a sl st and sew in the ends.*

### **Shape the head and the eye sockets:**

*With Teddy, thread a needle with approx. 25 cm yarn.*

*Put the needle in from under the chin and out at the side of the eye.*

*Guide the thread around some stitches by the eye and then back out under the chin. Tighten the yarn to form the hollow around the eye, tighten the yarn through a few stitches under the chin.*

*Repeat for the other side of the same eye.*

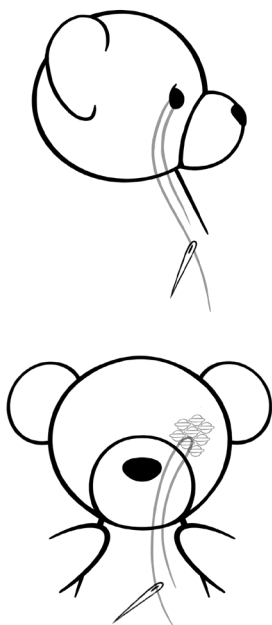
*The hollow for the eye is now completed. Should you want the hollow deeper the process can be repeated and a stitch added towards the top of the eye.*

*Remember to always keep the yarn tight when the needle is pulled out under the chin, during the sewing to keep the tension and for the hollow to become permanent.*

*Repeat the process for the other eye.*

*See illustration.*

*Sew on eyebrows using the black yarn.*



## SNOUT

- 1.) Crochet 7 ch. 2 dc in the 2. ch from the hook, 4 dc, 3 dc in the last ch. Continue back again on the opposite side of the chain row: 5 dc (14)

*Add a thread as marker*

- 2.) 2 dc inc, 2 dc, 2 dc inc x 2, 2 dc, 2 dc inc, 6 dc (18)
- 3.) 2 dc inc x 2, 3 dc, 2 dc inc x 2, 3 dc, 2 dc inc x 2, 6 dc (24)
- 4.) 1 dc, 2 dc inc x 2, 5 dc, 2 dc inc x 2, 5 dc, 2 dc inc x 2, 7 dc (30)
- 5.) 1 dc, 2 dc inc x 2, 7 dc, 2 dc inc x 2, 7 dc, 2 dc inc x 2, 9 dc (36)
- 6.) 36 dc (36)
- 7.) 12 dc, dc 2 tog x 2, 20 dc (34)
- 8.) 34 dc (34)

*Close with a sl st.*

*Add filler to the snout.*

*Use the yarn end to sew the snout to the head.*

*Embroider on the mouth and snout (see drawing).*

## EARS (2 X)

- 1.) cr with 5 dc (5)  
*Turn the magic ring. From here, you crochet back and forth.*
- 2.) t-ch, \*2 dc inc\* (10)
- 3.) \*1 dc, 2 dc inc\* (15)
- 4.) t-ch, \*2 dc, 2 dc inc\* (20)  
*Hold the two parts against each other, back to back and crochet them together.*
- 5.) t-ch, 20 dc (20)  
*Cast off and use the yarn end to sew the ears to the head.*

## ARMS (2 X)

- 1.) cr with 6 dc (6)
  - 2.) \*2 dc inc\* (12)
  - 3.) \*1 dc, 2 dc inc\* (18)
  - 4.) \*2 dc, 2 dc inc\* (24)
  5. - 6.) 24 dc (24)
  - 7.) \*2 dc, dc 2 tog\* (18)
  8. - 9.) 18 dc (18)
  - 10.) \*1 dc, dc 2 tog\* (12)
  11. - 30.) 12 dc (12)
  - 31.) \*dc 2 tog\* (6)  
*Add filler to the arms.*
- Cast off and use the yarn end to sew the arms to the body.*



## LEGS (2 X)

- 1.) cr with 6 dc (6)
  - 2.) \*2 dc inc\* (12)
  - 3.) \*1 dc, 2 dc inc\* (18)
  - 4.) \*2 dc, 2 dc inc\* (24)
  - 5.) \*3 dc, 2 dc inc\* (30)
  - 6.) \*3 dc, dc 2 tog\* (24)
  - 7.) 10 dc, dc 2 tog x 2, 10 dc (22)
  - 8.) 10 dc, dc 2 tog, 10 dc (21)
  - 9.) 3 dc, dc 2 tog x 4, 10 dc (17)
  10. - 27.) 17 dc (17)
  - 28.) \*2 dc, dc 2 tog\* x 4, 1 dc (13)
  - 29.) \*dc 2 tog\* x 6, 1 dc (7)  
*Add filler to the legs.*
- Cast off and use the yarn end to sew the legs to the body.*





# Good to know

## Hook Size + Tension

Crocheters crochet very differently: some crochet with a hook size 2,0 mm and obtain the same size of design and quality as a person who crochets with a hook size 4,0 mm. We owe this knowledge to the team of crocheters who join us.

The key to crochet a specific size is a lot about the crochet style/hands/skills, rather than the size of hook. Therefore, we will recommend a range of hook sizes.



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
