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# CROCHET & KNITTING

Safe handling and assembling



### YARN USAGE:

Teddy H 40 cm: 250 g

A few meters of black yarn for mouth, snout and eyebrows.

### **MATERIALS:**

Eyes: 14 mm Filling

Crochet hook: 3,0 - 3,5 mm

The given amounts of yarn are for guidance only.

If nothing else is specified, work in spiral rounds. To finish the work, join the round with a sl st. Leave a 20 cm length of yarn and cut. Pull the yarn through the stitch.

It is recommended that the filling continues on an ongoing basis as the work progresses.

## **REQUIRED MOUNTING STEPS**

Eyes in yarn projects (0-3 years)

For projects for children 0-3 years: Mounting of eyes requires melting of end pieces and special stitching.

A "fluffy" yarn, that doesn't require any special techniques or stitches to get a nice and chunky result. Use Teddy for cuddle animals to give them a real "teddy" look or knit/crochet a blanket for babies/toddlers.

Teddy has been awarded the AZO certificate and is thus a yarn that everyone can feel safe wearing.

100% Polyester, 50 g/65 m.

### **SNOUT**

1.) Crochet 7 ch. 2 dc in the 2. ch from the hook, 4 dc, 3 dc in the last ch.
Continue back again on the opposite side of the chain row: 5 dc (14)

#### Add a thread as marker

- 2.) 2 dc inc, 2 dc, 2 dc inc x 2, 2 dc, 2 dc inc, 6 dc (18) 3.) 2 dc inc x 2, 3 dc, 2 dc inc x 2,
- 3.) 2 dc inc x 2, 3 dc, 2 dc inc x 2, 3 dc, 2 dc inc x 2, 6 dc (24)
- 4.) 1 dc, 2 dc inc x 2, 5 dc, 2 dc inc x 2, 5 dc, 2 dc inc x 2, 7 dc (30)

Add filler to the snout.

Use the yarn end to sew the snout to the head. Embroider on the mouth and snout (see drawing).

# Hook Size & Tension

Crocheters crochet very differently: some crochet with a hook size 2,0 mm and obtain the same size of design and quality as a person who crochets with a hook size 4,0 mm. We owe this knowledge to the team of crocheters who join us. The key to crochet a specific size is a lot about the crochet style/hands/skills, rather than the size of hook. Therefore, we will recommend a range of hook sizes.



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
