Colour A: 100 g

Colour B: a few meters

For the hair: a few meters

Gauge: 19 dc/10 cm

Crocheted in Go handmade's Bohème Velvet "double" - a delicate and super soft top quality velour yarn: 100% Polyester, 50 g/70 m.

MATERIALS

Tumble ball: 9,1 x 9,1 cm

Rattle cellophane, Filling

Safety eyes: 10 mm

Crochet hook: 3,5 - 4,0 mm

YARN USAGE

Tumble duck: H18 cm
Colour A: 100 g
Colour B: few meters
For the hair: few meters

MATERIALS

Tumble Ball: 9,1 x 9,1 cm
Rattle cellophane
Filling
Safety eyes: 10 mm
Crochet hook: 3,5 - 4,0 mm
Gauge: 19 dc/10 cm

The given amounts of yarn are for guidance only.

If nothing else is specified, work in spiral rounds.
To finish the work, join the round with a sl st.
Leave a 20 cm length of yarn and cut. Pull the yarn through the stitch.

REQUIRED MOUNTING STEPS

Eyes in yarn projects (0-3 years)

For projects for children 0-3 years:
Mounting of eyes requires melting of end pieces and special stitching.

ABBREVIATIONS AND DEFINITIONS

st(s)	Stitch(es)
mr	Magic ring
ch	Chain stitch
sl st	Slip stitch
dc	Double crochet
1 dc inc	Increase (2 dc in one st)
2 dc tog	Decrease (2 dc worked together)
* ... *	The instructions shown between these stars must be repeated for the whole round/row or with the number indicated after x.
(..)	At the end of the round/row - indicates the total number of stitches.

Everybody will love the feel of this soft yarn – top quality at its best.

Recommended machine wash at 40° C.

100% Polyester,
50 g/70 m.



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TUMBLE DUCK

HEAD (COLOUR A)

| 7. - 14.) | 36 dc | (36) |

Insert the safety eyes between rounds 8 and 9, with 5 dc in-between.

Stuff the head with filling.

Shape the eye hollows:

With Bohème Velvet "double", thread a needle with approx. 25 cm yarn.

Put the needle in from under the chin and out at the side of the eye.

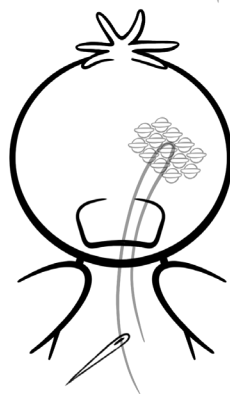
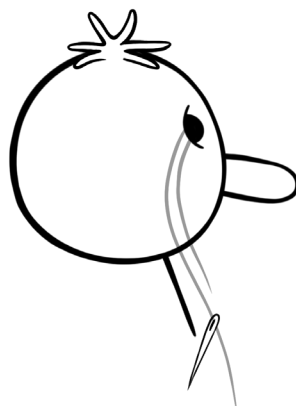
Guide the thread around some stitches by the eye and then back out under the chin. Tighten the yarn to form the hollow around the eye, tighten the yarn through a few stitches under the chin.

The hollow for the eye is now completed.

Should you want the hollow deeper the process can be repeated and a stitch added towards the top of the eye.

Repeat the process for the other eye.

BEAK (COLOUR B)

Attach the beak on round 11 of the head.

HAIR

For the hair, cut a few pieces of yarn of 10 cm long. Pull them through a stitch so they lie double. Attach them with a knot and cut.

Assembling:

Note that both the bottom and top pieces must be close to the Tumble ball and therefore it should be a little tight to get the tumble ball in. The two pieces are sewn together with the Tumble ball inside. The head is sewn on top of the body (Tumble ball).

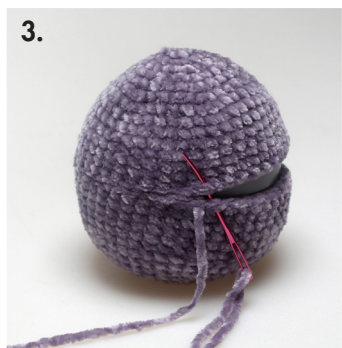

WINGS (COLOUR A, 2 X)

1.)	mr with 6 dc	(6)
2.)	* 1 dc inc*	(12)
3. - 4.)	12 dc	(12)
5.)	* 1 dc, 1 dc inc*	(18)
6. - 7.)	18 dc	(18)
8.)	* 2 dc, 1 dc inc*	(24)
9. - 10.)	24 dc	(24)
11.)	* 1 dc, 2 dc tog*	(16)
12. - 13.)	16 dc	(16)
14.)	* 2 dc tog*	(8)
15. - 16.)	8 dc	(8)

Add 2 layers of Rattle cellophane to the wings and sew them onto the body as shown in the pictures. Cut the yarn.





Good to know

Hook Size + Tension

Crocheters crochet very differently: some crochet with a hook size 2,0 mm and obtain the same size of design and quality as a person who crochets with a hook size 4,0 mm. We owe this knowledge to the team of crocheters who join us. The key to crochet a specific size is a lot about the crochet style/hands/skills, rather than the size of hook. Therefore, we will recommend a range of hook sizes.



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
