

I-Cord Knit on 2 double-pointed needles.

Instead of turning the work, push the stitches to the other end of the needle. Use the thread from the back and knit the row again. Repeat this.

#### TAIL

Cast on 3 stitches.

Knit an I-cord until the work measures 11 cm. Cut the yarn, pull it through the stitches with a darning needle, and pull tight.

1. Cut a piece of wire about 19 cm long.

- 2. Bend one end of the wire 1 cm down/inward this will form the tip of the tail.
- 3. Insert the wire piece into the back of the mouse's body so that it extends up to the opening.
- 4. At the opening, make a 1 cm bend in the wire so it goes back down into the body by about 3-5 cm.

This gives the mouse balance, as the wire functions as a tail that stabilizes the mouse.

Insert the wire into the tail. Sew the tail on.

#### ARMS (2 X)

Cast on 4 sts and knit I-cord

1. - 10.) I-cord

Pull the yarn through the remaining stitches, tighten. Cut approx.  $2 \times 5$  cm of wire.

Bend the wire 1 cm down at one end, this is the hand.

Insert the wire into the arm as shown in the illustration (p. 2).

Add filling.

Place the other end of the wire on the body, near the shoulders, and sew the arm in place. Repeat this for the other arm.

#### **LEG (2 X)**

Cast on 8 sts on and knit in the round.

#### Assembly:

Weave in all yarn ends. Lightly press the coat if necessary.

Sew a button on one side of the coat, in the middle. Attach a piece of yarn on the opposite side of the button and make a loop for a buttonhole. Sew buttonhole stitch all around the loop. Weave in the ends.

Sew the lace ribbon to the neckline.

Make small pleats, evenly distributed

## Good to know

Needle Size & Tension

Knitters knit very differently: some knit with a needle size 2,0 mm and obtain the same size of design quality as a person who knits with a needle size 4,0 mm. We owe this knowledge to the team of knitters who join us. The key to knit a specific size is a lot about the knitting style/hands/skills, rather than the size of needles.



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
